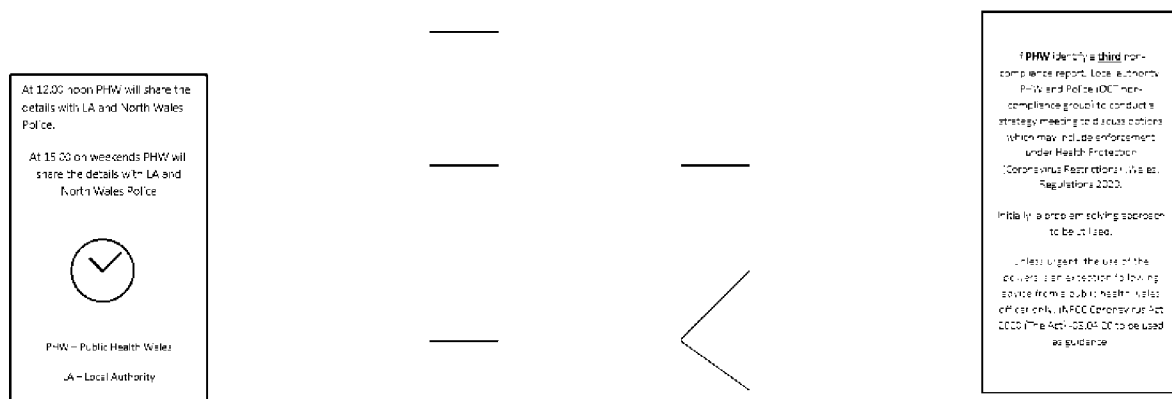


## Non-compliance summary for 2 Sisters Outbreak Report- [REDACTED]

10.07.2020

On 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2020 it was decided by the OCT, that a separate task and finish group be set up to discuss a protocol to deal with breaches of compliance. This was in relation to the requirement for all 2 Sisters staff to self-isolate for 14 days from their last day at the Llangefni site, and in response to concerns raised by members of public to the local authority and police that some staff were not compliant with the requirement. The action (78/20) required the group to include Public Health Wales (PHW) as proper officers, EHOs from Anglesey and Gwynedd, [REDACTED] (Director of Public Health), Food Standards Agency, Health and Safety Executive and North Wales Police. With agreement from [REDACTED], [REDACTED] (Public Health Registrar) set up a meeting with local authorities, environmental health, public protection and food standards staff (Gwynedd, Isle of Anglesey, Flintshire) and North Wales Police, with [REDACTED] as chair, representing PHW. The meeting was held on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2020. A protocol was agreed and circulated to members, see below. PHW agreed to hold a log of non-compliance concerns, and email round daily with updates. The legality of information sharing was agreed by PHW staff, as covered under current public health legislation.
