Following a verbal update and data circulated post committee meeting, this slide deck aims to:

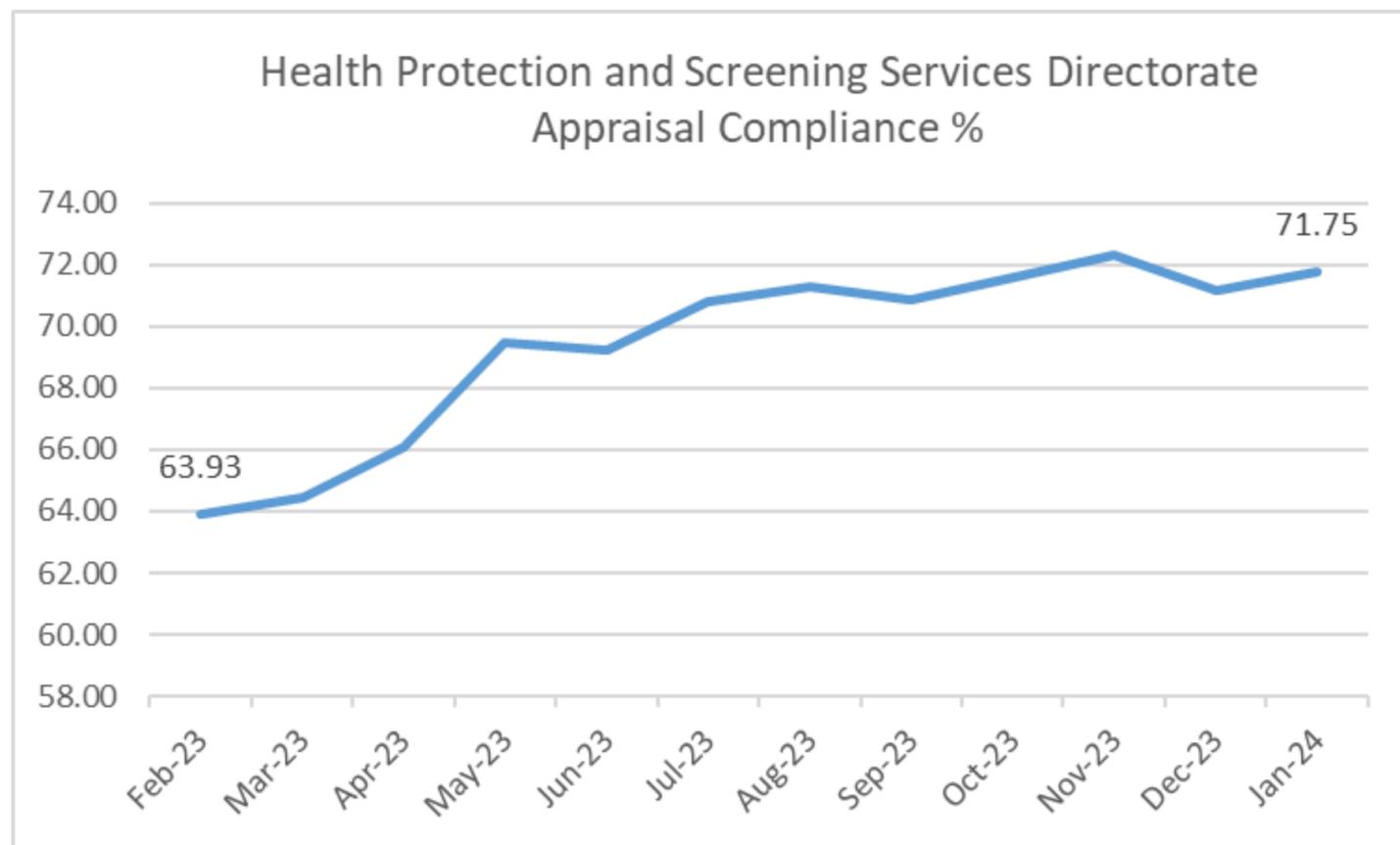
- Remind the committee of the deep dive data shared in February 2024.

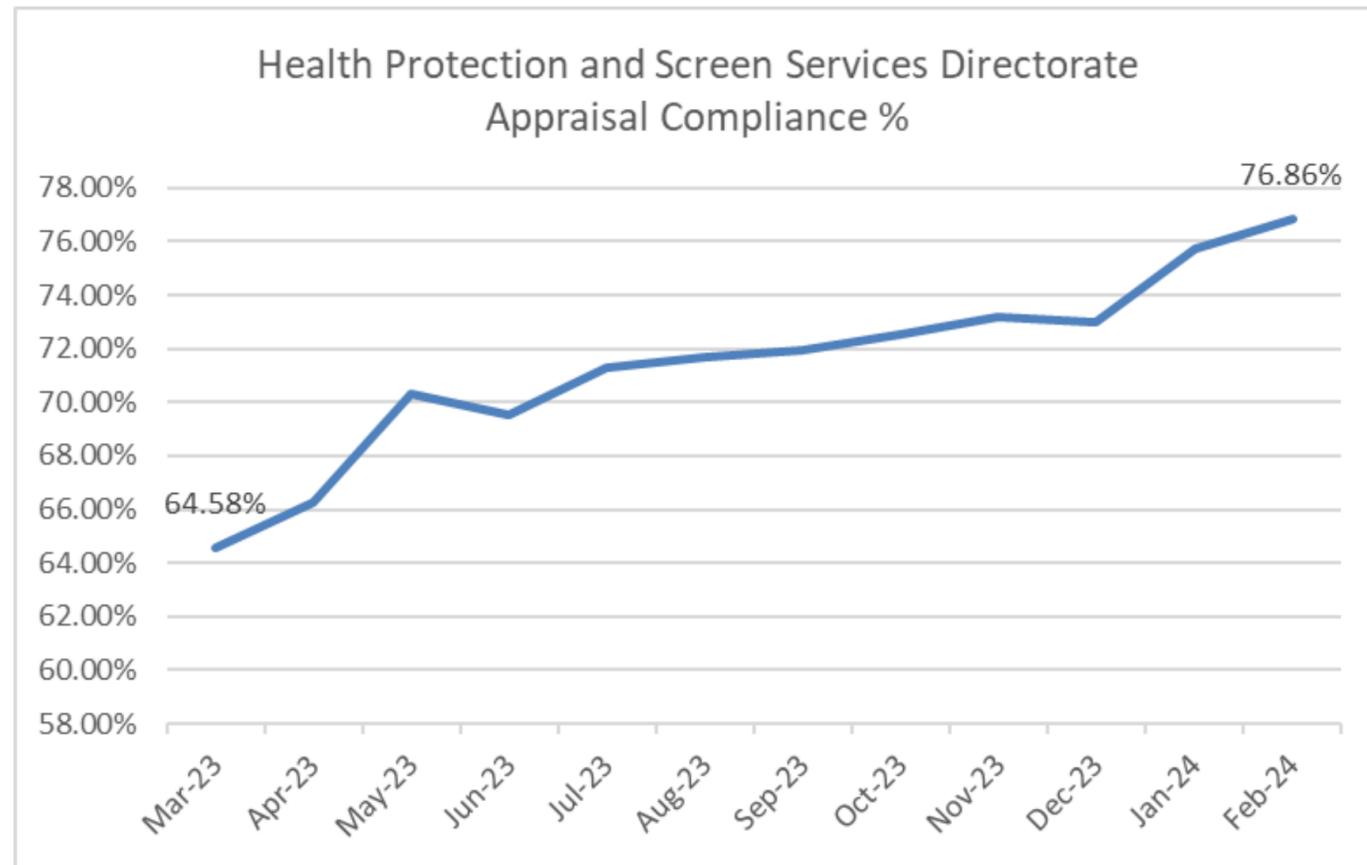

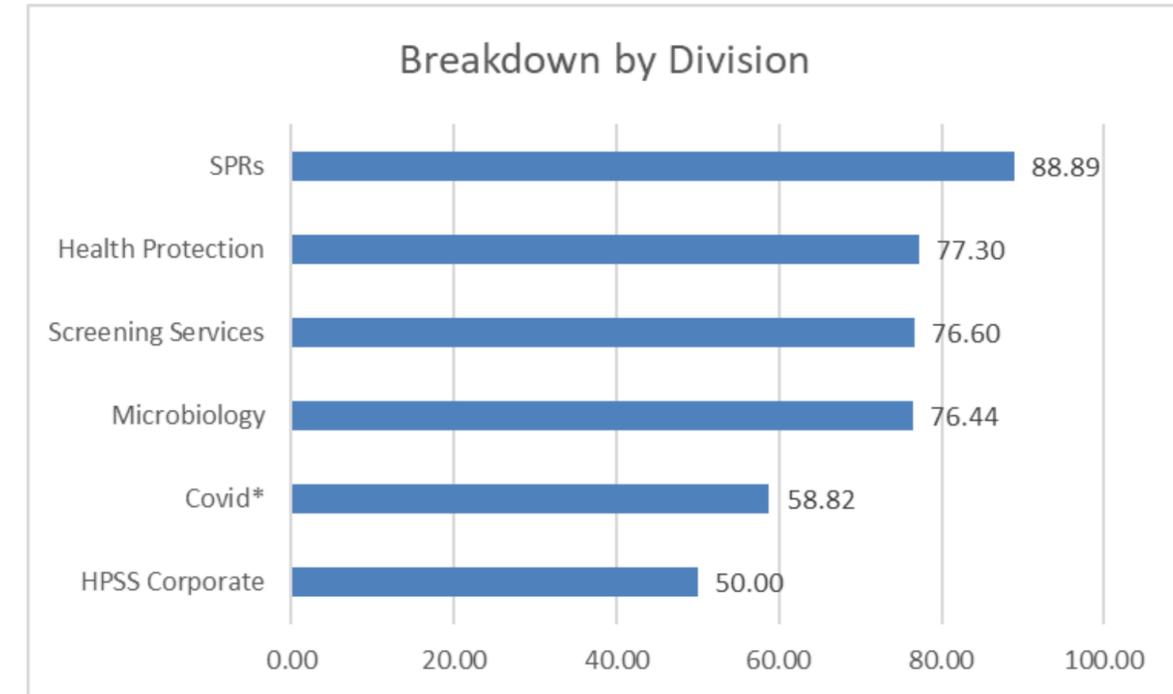

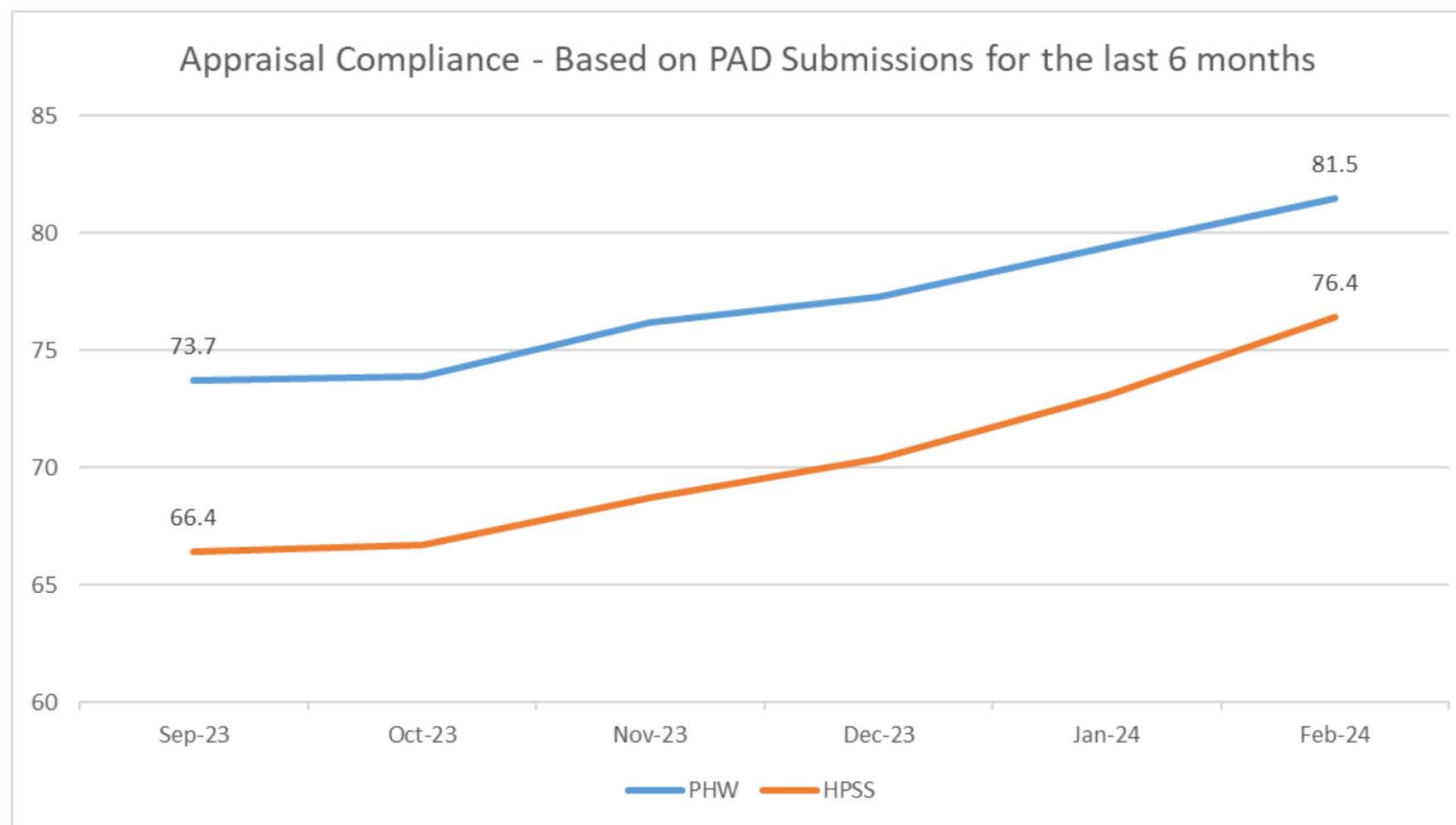

The figures in the previous slide include retrospective changes that managers have been making since the interventions were introduced.

This chart shows Appraisal Compliance data from the last 6 months Board Report submissions, which provides a more accurate picture of the improvements that have been made.



PHW = 7.8% increase

HP&SS = 10% increase

Work to improve the position

Work commenced in September to explore and understand the position which included:

Discussions with Directorate leadership team and line managers to understand the challenges. The discussions highlighted issues relating to:

- Accuracy of data in the system
- Reporting lines, large numbers of direct reports
- Dual roles / assignments
- Medical and consultant colleagues – Job planning and professional appraisal
- Competence / confidence
- Time and capacity

Work to improve the position

Support to improve

Leadership priority – People at the heart of all we do, responsibility to support and enable them to excel in PHW

- Agenda items on Directorate and Divisional leadership meetings reporting progress
- Specific workshop with Directorate Management Team in February 24.

Reporting lines – Review on case-by-case basis where line managers have large numbers

Confidence – A comprehensive series of training and drop in ESR sessions for managers delivered by POD twice a month. “Buddy” system introduced for less experienced managers.

Time and logistics – Support to upload data onto ESR as an exception. Reviewing workflows to enable time for meaningful MyC conversations.

Accuracy of data – Working with managers and POD colleagues to identify and correct anomalies.

Data accessibility – Working with POD colleagues to develop detailed reporting temporarily.

Looking forward

Achieving compliance

- All functional areas have a bespoke and realistic improvement trajectory developed by the Senior Operations Manager for the Division.
- These are reviewed both at divisional and directorate level monthly.
- With the exception of one area, all are projecting reaching compliance by the end of Q1 2024/25
- The final area by Q2 2024/25 (65% by end of April; 70% end of May; 75% end of June; 78% end of July; 80% end of August; 85% end of September).

Maintaining compliance

- Monitor the impact of amended systems and processes.
 - Continue with monthly divisional reporting with escalation to directorate for any deviation.
