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1. Purpose / situation

The purpose of this report is to review the Committee's terms of reference as part of the annual review, and recommend any changes to the Board for approval.

The terms of reference were last reviewed, in detail, in November 2019.

The Terms of Reference for the Audit and Corporate Governance Committee, the Quality, Safety and Improvement Committee were reviewed and the Standard Terms of Reference and Operating Arrangements for Committees were reviewed by the Committees in January / February 2021. The Committees recommended changes to the Terms of Reference to the Board on 27 May 2021.

No changes were made to the Standard Terms of Reference and Operating Arrangements for Committees.

As the People and Organisational Development Committee Terms of Reference was not in operation during January and February 2021 when the review took place, it was agreed that a review of these terms of reference be undertaken once the Committee reconvened.

2. Background

The Quality, Safety and Improvement Committee Terms of Reference which included the addition of Health and Safety matters, and the following changes were made to the People and Organisational Development Committee Terms of Reference in May 2021 to align these changes.

Purpose	Removal of:
	'assurance to the Board in relation to the effectiveness of the arrangements in place to ensure organisational wide compliance with the health, safety and welfare requirements.'
Delegated powers	Removal of:
	'seek assurances that there is the appropriate culture and arrangements to allow the Trust to discharge its statutory and mandatory responsibilities with regard to health, safety and welfare.'

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	Removal of: 'Receive reports of near misses, incidents, serious adverse incidents and claims relating to the health, safety and welfare of staff.'
6.2 Attendees	Revised title: National Director of Health Protection and Screening Services/Medical Director to replace Executive Director Public Health Services / Medical Director.
	Removal of: Deputy Chief Executive and Executive Director of Operations and Finance (Executive Lead for Health and Safety) or nominated deputy. As this has transferred to Quality, Safety and Improvement Committee.
