- Strategy and Delivery, including:
 - Progress against our IMTP Milestones and Strategic Change Programmes; Climate change; and Service Delivery

Structure of the report

The overall structure of the report comprises of a high level **Overview** for each governance theme, focusing on compliance against our statutory, mandated or other key reporting requirements. Each governance theme is supported by an **In Focus** section, providing additional assurance to our Board where challenges in our performance have been identified. The **In Focus** section will highlight the challenges and the actions identified to address underperformance and drive improvement.

Enhanced navigation is provided throughout the report. Readers will be able to access all governance themes via the hyperlinked icons in the banner at the top of each page. In addition readers will be able to access relevant *In Focus* areas or additional documents and *dashboards within the PAD* using the buttons accessible within the report. Examples of icons are provided below:





Phase 2 progress and future development

The current version of the performance report was implemented in autumn 2023 and was the first phase of a longer term programme of work to review and refresh our entire suite of performance indicators aligned to our strategy delivery.

Phase 2 of the project will run through to the publication of the Month 1 report in

2024/25 (due May 2024) and will prioritise the development of service delivery performance reporting for areas of the organisation under-represented within the Performance and Insights Report and Performance and Assurance Dashboard (where available).

Progress as at Month 11 includes;

- Ongoing engagement with Directorates identified as part of the phase 2 developments continues;
 - Policy and International Health proposed indicators identified and will be developing a 'mock up' as part of month 12 reporting
 - Health Protection and Screening Services final stages of agreeing key indicators across respective divisions with the aim of developing a 'mock up' prior to commencing month 1 reporting. Screening Division has continued engagement with Quality, Safety & Improvement Committee and Board as part of Audit Wales recommendations.
 - Health and Wellbeing progressing work with key areas to identify key insights and appropriate indicators. Aim to develop a 'mock up' as part of month 12 reporting
 - Data, Knowledge and Research progressing work with key areas to identify key insights and appropriate measures. Aim to develop a 'mock up' as part of month 12 reporting

The 'mock up' reports will be used purely for internal purposes as a trial run prior to formal month 1 reporting and will not be published.

- Procurement of consultant support agreed and work commenced at the end of February 2024 to develop new Corporate Governance and Information Governance dashboards. Additional dashboards for key areas to be developed (where data is available) and improvements of existing dashboards to better align to the Insights Report.
- Meeting held with Director of Improvement Cymru in March 2024 to discuss opportunities to improve areas of existing reporting. Examples of best practice have been shared and a recommendation to discuss further with an external agency (BCN Group).

In addition to the planned phase 2 work we also continue to incorporate Board feedback into the development and improvement of our current reporting.

Following the completion and implementation of phase 2 developments, phase 3 will focus on the different tiers of performance reporting and management throughout the organisation and will commence in 2024/25.
