Vaccine Uptake in Children in Wales

April to June 2026

COVER 159: Wales August 2026

Key points

- For children at one year of age, uptake of the “6 in 1” vaccine and two doses of MenB remains below 95%. Uptake of primary pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV) was 92.2%. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine was 90.6%.
- Uptake of a complete three-dose course of MenB vaccine in two-year-olds was 91.5% this quarter.
- From 1st January 2026, varicella vaccination was introduced into the routine childhood immunisation schedule and is now delivered as part of the combined MMRV vaccine. MMRV is the only MMR-containing vaccine being offered from 1st January 2026 to children born from 1st January 2020 [1]. Throughout this report, references to MMR1 and MMR2 also include a small number of children who would have attended their appointment late and received MMRV.
- Uptake of the first dose of MMR vaccine in two-year-old children was 91.5% this quarter. Uptake of the second dose in four-year-old children was 86.0%.
- The proportion of children up to date with all routine immunisations by four years of age was 83.8% this quarter and was 87.2% in five-year-olds.
- School-based vaccination sessions for teenagers are ongoing for the 2025-26 academic year. Uptake of one dose of HPV vaccine in 2025-26 school year 8 children is currently 66.8% and will increase over the next quarter as more vaccination sessions take place.
- Coverage of one dose of HPV vaccine in 2025-26 school year 9 (13–14-year-olds) is 74.7%. Coverage of one dose of HPV vaccine in 2025-26 school year 10 (14–15-year-olds) is 76.9%.
- Uptake of routine MenACWY vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 9 cohort is currently 69.2%. Coverage of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 10 cohort is 75.9%.
- Uptake of the routine Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2025-26 school year 9 cohort is currently 69.5%. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2025-26 school year 10 is 76.1%.
- Coverage of one dose of MMR vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 10 (age 14-15 years) was 96.0%, coverage of two doses was 93.3%.
- Coverage of one dose of MMR vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 11 (age 15-16 years) was 95.9%, coverage of two doses was 93.5%.

Background

These results are for children living in Wales in June 2026 and reaching their first, second, fourth, fifth and 16th birthdays during the quarter 01/04/2026 to 30/06/2026. Uptake of key immunisations in older children, which are mainly provided through school-based programmes in all areas other than Cardiff and Vale University Health Board, are presented in school year cohorts (children reaching their 13th, 14th, 15th and 16th birthdays between 01/09/2025 and 31/08/2026). BCG immunisation uptake data are also presented here for children vaccinated selectively following risk assessment. Coverage of neonatal hepatitis B immunisation in infants at risk is also presented, using data from the Public Health Wales Tarian case and incident management system following a move from the Public Health Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B database.



Findings

1. Uptake of all three doses of the combined “6 in 1” DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB¹ vaccine, scheduled at two, three and four months of age, in children reaching their first birthday was 92.0% this quarter, 0.6% lower than last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 90.4% (Hywel Dda) to 95.4% (Powys Teaching) and by LA from 86.8% (Denbighshire) to 96.4% (Anglesey). One of the seven HBs and two of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2, 3 and 6, Tables 2 and 3).
2. Uptake of primary pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV) in children reaching their first birthday decreased to 92.2% this quarter, compared to 93.8% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 90.4% (Hywel Dda) to 95.4% (Powys Teaching) and by LA from 87.7% (Denbighshire) to 96.4% (Anglesey). One of the seven HBs and four of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 3).
3. Uptake of two doses of MenB vaccine, scheduled at two and four months of age, in children reaching their first birthday was 93.7% this quarter. Uptake in HBs ranged from 91.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.5% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 89.9% (Ceredigion) to 97.2% (Flintshire) (Figure 3, Tables 2 and 3).
4. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine in children reaching their first birthday was 90.6% this quarter, compared to 90.8% last quarter. Uptake in HBs ranged from 88.1% (Cardiff and Vale) to 94.0% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 84.5% (Ceredigion) to 94.6% (Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 3).
5. Uptake of the first dose of MMR² in children reaching their second birthday (scheduled at 12 to 13 months of age) was 91.5% this quarter compared to 91.9% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 89.4% (Cardiff and Vale) to 94.8% (Powys Teaching) and by LA area from 86.7% (Torfaen) to 95.1% (Caerphilly). None of the seven HBs and one of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2, 3 and 7, Tables 2 and 4).
6. Uptake of the complete three dose course of MenB vaccine in children reaching their second birthday was 91.5%. Uptake ranged by HB from 89.4% (Cardiff and Vale) to 94.8% (Powys Teaching) and by LA from 87.3% (Blaenau Gwent) to 94.7% (Anglesey). None of the seven HBs and none of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 4).
7. Uptake of the final dose of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf), (scheduled at 12 to 13 months of age) in children reaching their second birthday was 91.4%. Uptake ranged by HB from 89.1% (Cardiff and Vale) to 94.0% (Swansea Bay) and ranged by LA from 87.3% (Blaenau Gwent) to 94.7% (Anglesey and Swansea). None of the seven HBs and none of the LA areas achieved an uptake of 95% or over (Figure 3, Tables 2 and 4).
8. Uptake of the Hib/MenC booster (given at 12 to 13 months of age) in children reaching two years of age was 88.4% this quarter, compared to 90.6% last quarter. From 1st July 2025, the offer of Hib/MenC booster was removed from the routine childhood immunisation schedule [2]. Children who turn one year of age on or before 30th June 2025, and present late to the one-year vaccination appointment after 1st July 2025, will instead be offered an additional fourth dose of the DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB (hexavalent) vaccine [1]. In this report, uptake of Hib/MenC booster will also include a small number of those with no recorded Hib/MenC booster but who received the additional hexavalent vaccine from 1st July 2025. Uptake ranged by HB from 85.3% (Cardiff and Vale) to 92.5% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg and Powys Teaching) and ranged by LA from 79.3% (Conwy) to 93.9% (Anglesey). None of the seven HBs and none of the LA areas achieved the target uptake of 95% or over (Figures 1, 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 4).

9. In children reaching four years of age this quarter (Table 5), uptake of:

- The “4 in 1” DTaP/IPV³ pre-school booster was 85.2%
- The Hib/MenC booster was 93.5%
- Two doses of MMR² was 86.0%

The proportion of children who were up to date with all these routine immunisations at four years of age was 83.8%. This ranged by HB from 78.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 87.7% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 76.5% (Cardiff) to 95.3% (Ceredigion) (Figures 4 and 5, Tables 1, 2 and 5).

- 10.** The proportion of children who were up to date with routine immunisations by their fifth birthday was 87.2%, compared to 87.5% last quarter. This ranged by HB from 83.6% (Cardiff and Vale) to 90.8% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) (Table 6).
- 11.** In children reaching five years of age this quarter, coverage of one dose of MMR² was 95.0%. Coverage of two doses of MMR² was 89.4%. Coverage of two doses of MMR² ranged by HB from 87.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 92.8% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 82.0% (Newport) to 94.7% (Anglesey) (Figures 1, 2, 3 and 8, Tables 2, 6 and 7).
- 12.** Uptake of the “4 in 1” DTaP/IPV³ pre-school booster in children reaching their fifth birthday decreased to 88.8% this quarter, compared to 89.3% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 86.1% (Cardiff and Vale) to 91.6% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 80.7% (Newport) to 94.7% (Anglesey). None of the seven HBs and none of the 22 LA areas achieved the 95% uptake target (Figure 3 and 9, Tables 2, 6 and 7).
- 13.** Vaccination sessions for children in the 2025-26 school year 8 cohort (turning 13 years of age during 01/09/25 to 31/08/26) are ongoing. Uptake of one dose of HPV vaccine is currently 66.8% (70.2% in girls and 63.7% in boys) and will increase as more vaccination sessions take place (Tables 8a and 9).
- 14.** Coverage of one dose of HPV vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 9 cohort was 74.7% (77.3% in girls and 72.1% in boys) (Tables 8b and 9).
- 15.** Coverage of one dose of HPV vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 10 cohort (reaching their 15th birthday during 01/09/25 to 31/08/26) was 76.9% (79.2% in girls and 74.7% in boys) (Tables 8c and 9).
- 16.** Uptake of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 9 cohort is currently 69.2% (70.4% in girls and 68.2% in boys) (Tables 10a, 11 and 12).
- 17.** Uptake of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 10 cohort was 75.9% (76.4% in girls and 75.4% in boys) (Tables 10b, 11 and 13).
- 18.** Uptake of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 11 cohort was 76.8% (77.9% in girls and 75.9% in boys) (Tables 10c, 11 and 14).
- 19.** Uptake of the Td/IPV⁴ teenage booster in the 2025-26 school year 9 (children reaching 14 years of age) is currently 69.5%. Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 93.1% and coverage of one dose was 95.9%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 90.0% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.2% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg and Swansea Bay). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 14-year-old girls in this school year group was 93.3% (Table 12).

- 20.** Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2025-26 school year 10 (children reaching 15 years of age) was 76.1%. Coverage ranged by HB from 70.4% (Cardiff and Vale) to 84.3% (Swansea Bay). Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 93.3% and coverage of one dose was 96.0%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 90.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.0% (Betsi Cadwaladr and Swansea Bay). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 15-year-old girls in this school year group was 93.4% (Table 13).
- 21.** Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2025-26 school year 11 (children reaching 16 years of age) was 76.9%. Coverage ranged by HB from 71.0% (Aneurin Bevan) to 84.5% (Swansea Bay). Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 93.5% and coverage of one dose was 95.9%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 90.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.3% (Swansea Bay). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 16-year-old girls in this school year group was 93.4% (Table 14).
- 22.** Coverage of two doses of MMR in children reaching 16 years of age this quarter (between 1st April 2026 and 30th June 2026) was 93.7%, whilst coverage of one dose of MMR was 96.1%. Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 16-year-old girls was 93.4%. National coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in children reaching 16 years of age this quarter was 77.3% (Figures 1, 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 15).
- 23.** Uptake of BCG immunisation is presented in Table 16. These data are based on BCG immunisations recorded in the National Community Child Health Database. BCG immunisation has been received by 10.7%, 11.2%, 9.2% and 7.9% of children reaching their first, second, fifth and 16th birthdays (respectively) during quarter two of 2026. This quarter, Cardiff and Vale UHB had the highest proportion of children given BCG by one year of age (23.9%), two years of age (27.3%), five years of age (20.5%) and sixteen years of age (18.4%).
- 24.** Uptake data for hepatitis B immunisation in children who were at risk of perinatal infection, extracted from the Public Health Wales Tarian Database, are presented in Table 17. This quarter, uptake of three doses of hepatitis B vaccine at their first birthday was 100%, uptake of four doses was 100% at their second birthday, and uptake of four doses at their fifth birthday was 100%. Proportions should be interpreted with caution as small numbers of babies require an enhanced course of hepatitis B immunisation.



Comment

Uptake of immunisations in infants by their first birthday continues to show a declining trend. Uptake of the complete three-dose course of “6 in 1” vaccine was 92.0%, the lowest figure since Quarter One 2003, with one health board and two local authority areas achieving the target 95% uptake. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine remained stable at 90.6% this quarter, compared to 90.8% last quarter, with this slight decrease representing the lowest level of uptake observed since 2015. Uptake of PCV primary vaccination decreased to 92.2% this quarter, compared to 93.8% last quarter, falling below 95% for the fourth consecutive quarter.

Uptake of vaccinations at two years has also continued to decrease. Coverage of one dose of MMR-containing vaccine at two years decreased to 91.5%, with none of the health boards achieving the target 95% uptake. Following the changes to the childhood vaccination schedule on 1st January 2026, MMRV is now the only MMR-containing vaccine being offered to children born from 1st January 2020 and two-year-olds in this report attending for their MMR vaccine after 1st January 2026 would have received MMRV [1]. Uptake of Hib/MenC Booster vaccine was the lowest of all immunisations reported in this age group at 88.4%. However, children attending late for their appointment may have received a fourth dose of “6 in 1” instead of Hib/MenC to protect them against Hib, following the initial changes to the childhood vaccination schedule in July 2025 [2]. The proportion of children who were up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age decreased to 83.8% this quarter compared to 84.4% last quarter. There remains wide variation by health board. Uptake of the “4 in 1” preschool booster vaccine was the lowest of all vaccinations included in this composite measure at 85.2%. The proportion of children who were up to date with their routine immunisations by five years remained stable this quarter at 87.2%. Although there have been some quarterly fluctuations, the long-term trend in coverage of two doses of MMR by five years of age has been gradually decreasing since the first quarter of 2021. Uptake this quarter increased slightly to 89.4%, compared to 89.2% last quarter.

Uptake of one dose of HPV vaccine in the 2025-26 school year 8, year 9 and 10 cohorts is currently 66.8%, 74.7% and 76.9%, respectively. Uptake was higher in school year 9 and 10, compared to the equivalent groups at the same time last year (67.3%, 74.2% and 74.1%). Although most school sessions would have been completed at the time of this report, uptake may increase as more data are entered.

Uptake of MenACWY and Td/IPV remained stable in the 2025-26 school year 10 cohort compared to the previous school year 10 cohort. However, uptake is around eight percentage points lower than the 2019-20 academic year 10 group at the end of June 2020. Encouragingly, for adolescents reaching their 14th – 16th birthdays during the 2025-26 academic year, coverage of one dose of MMR exceeds 95% in most health board areas and coverage of a complete two dose course exceeds the measles and rubella elimination target of 95% in a number of health boards and local authority areas.

In 2024 there was a resurgence of measles across the UK, with 2,911 laboratory confirmed cases reported by the UKHSA, the highest recorded since 2012 [3]. This led to the WHO announcing that there was re-established transmission in the UK following three years of measles being eliminated [4]. During the second half of 2025 case numbers in England stabilised, however since January 2026 there has been an increase in confirmed cases, mainly around London and the West Midlands, with a total of 953 confirmed cases as at 6th August [3]. Three measles-related deaths have also been reported to date in 2026 [3].

Following an outbreak of Meningococcal Group B (MenB) in Kent in March, along with more recent smaller outbreaks in Weymouth and Reading, Welsh Government announced an urgent time-limited MenB vaccination programme starting from 20th July 2026 [5]. First doses will



continue to be available until 31st December 2026, and second doses available until 31st March 2027.

The MenB vaccination is being offered to two cohorts:

- Cohort 1: all individuals born between 01/09/2007 and 31/08/2008 (17 to 18 years old)
- Cohort 2: individuals born on or after 21/07/2001 (turning 25 on or after 21/07/2026) and are due to start undergraduate higher education OR residential further education, for the first time in autumn 2026, including international students and those from the UK Devolved Administrations and Crown Dependencies.

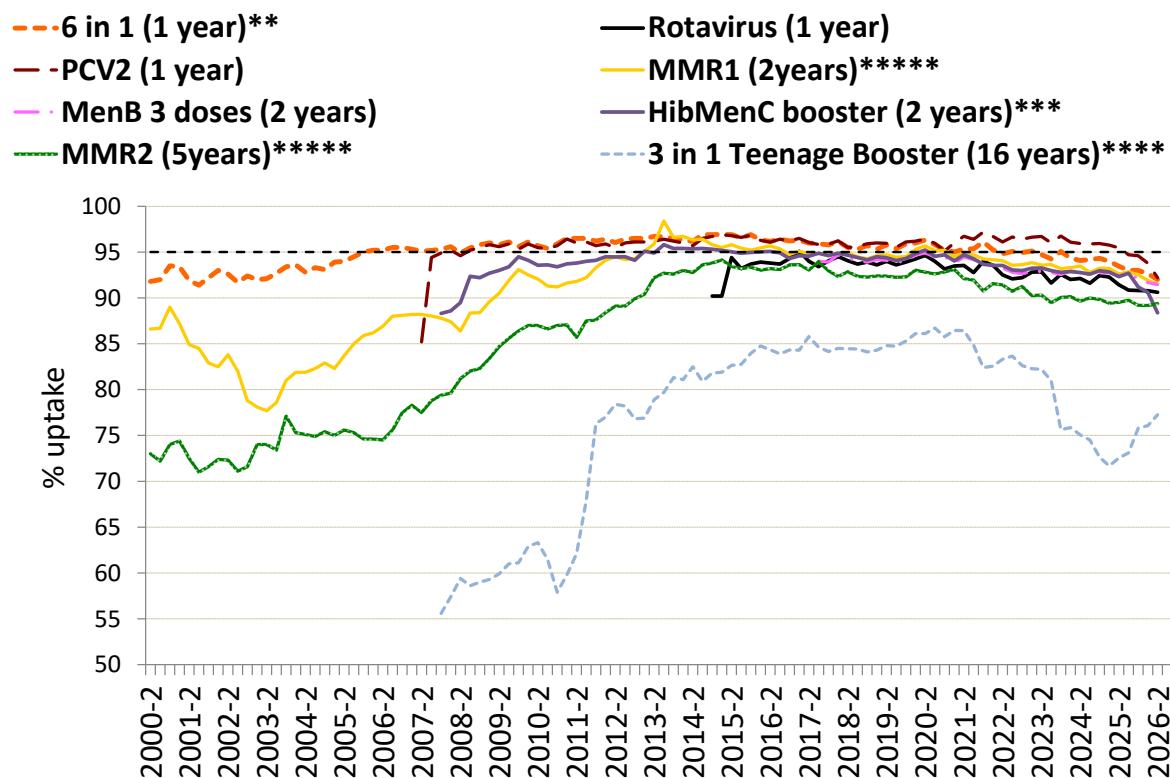

Data for this report was provided by Digital Health Care Wales from the National Community Child Health Database (NCCHD). The data was sourced from Community Child Health databases maintained by local Child Health Office staff in Trusts throughout Wales based on regular returns from nurses and doctors who immunise or advise on immunisation. Uptake data presented throughout are for HB resident population, not for HB GP practice populations. The maps, graphs, tables 1 and 2 are best viewed in colour.

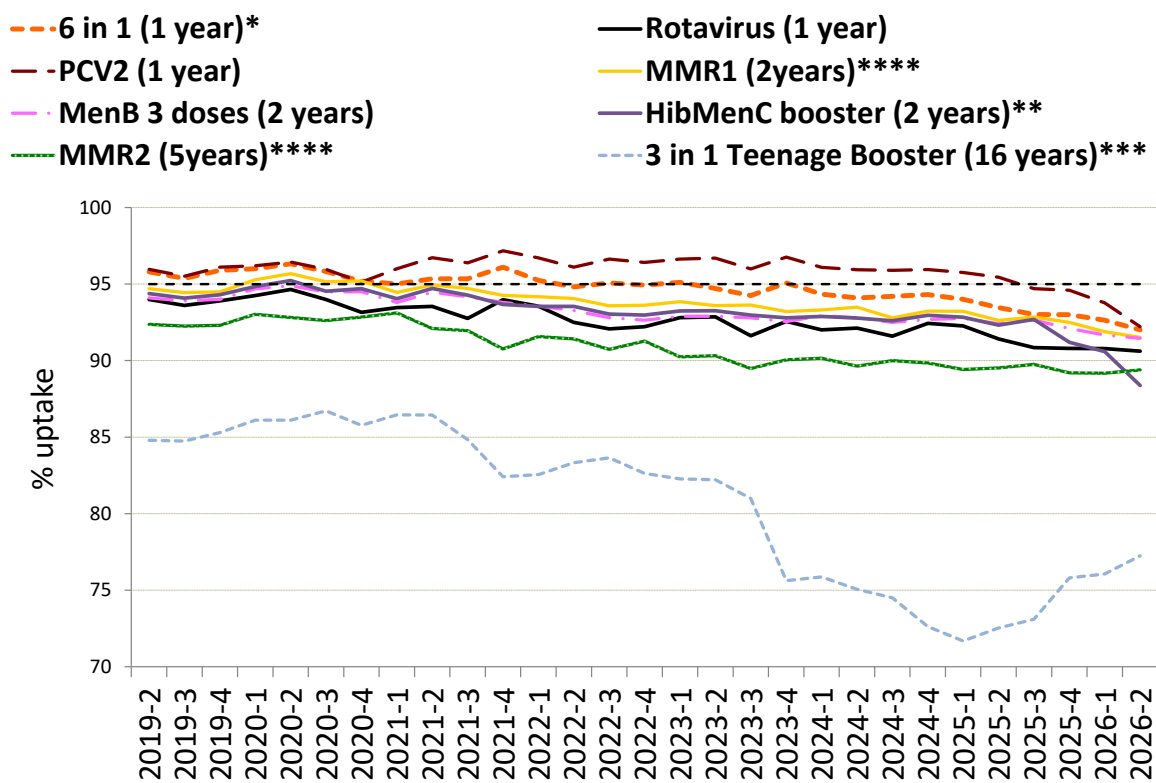

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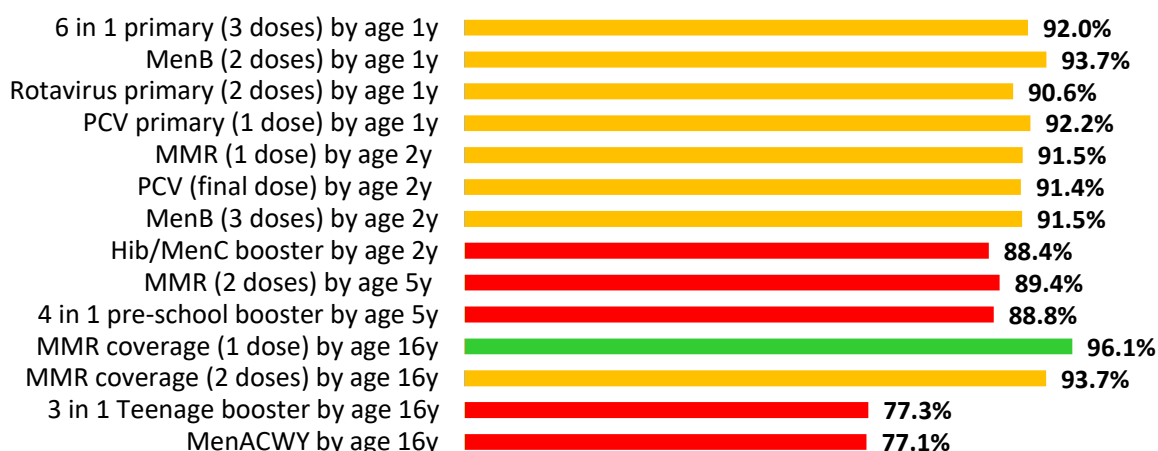


Figure 4. Percentage uptake of resident children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/04/26 and 30/06/26 and are up to date with all scheduled vaccines⁷ by health board.



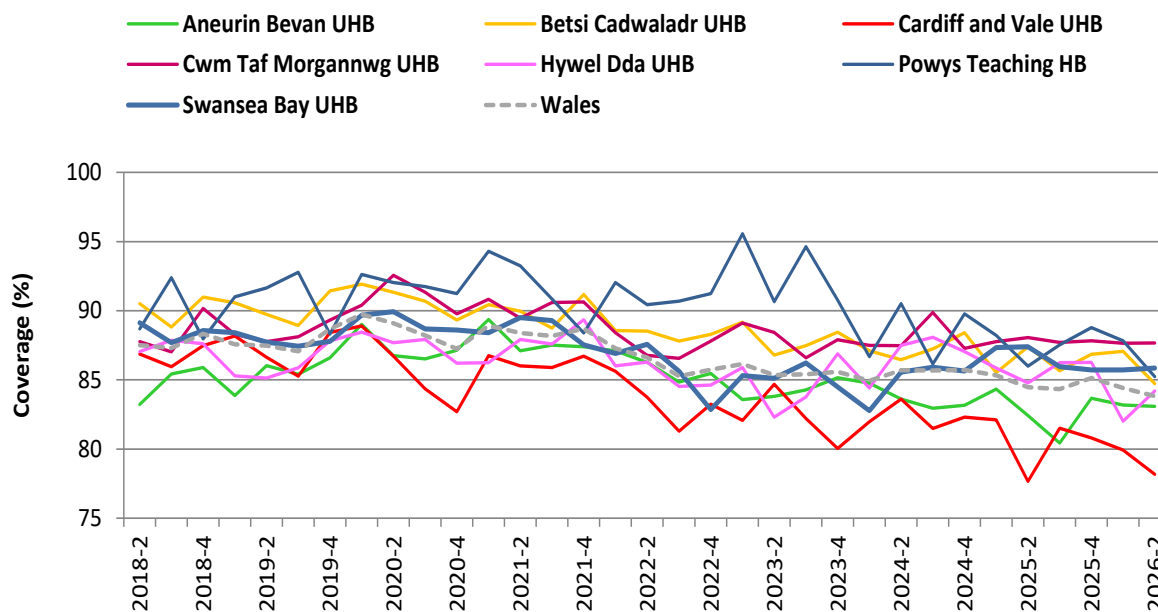

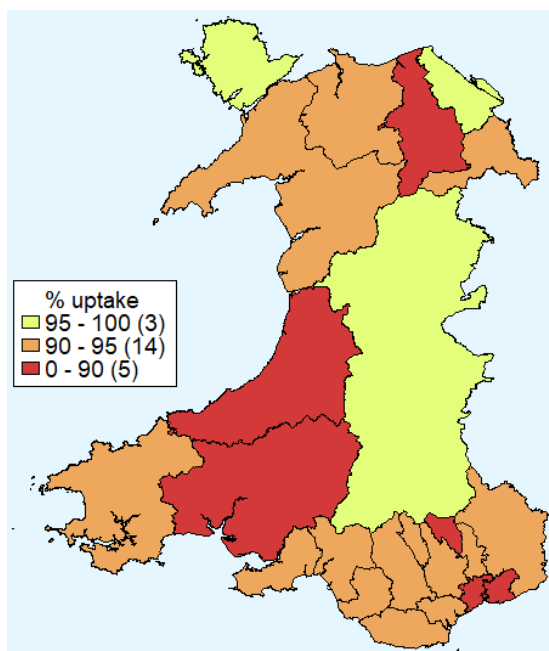


Figure 7. Uptake of at least one dose of MMR immunisation in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 2nd birthday between 01/04/26 and 30/06/26.

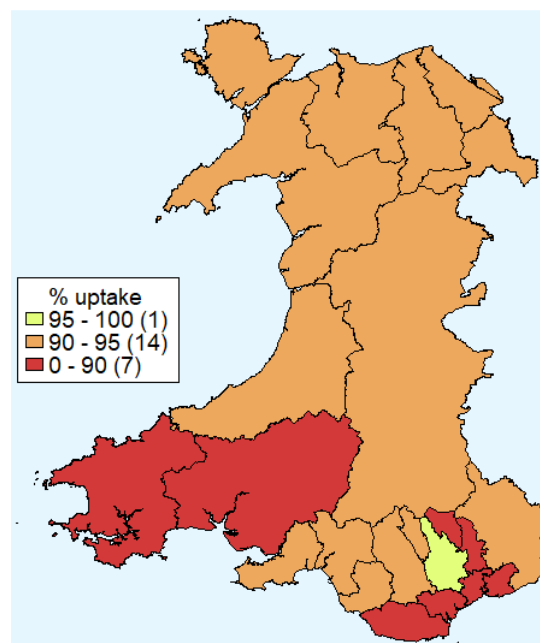


Figure 8. Uptake of two doses of MMR vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/26 and 30/06/26.

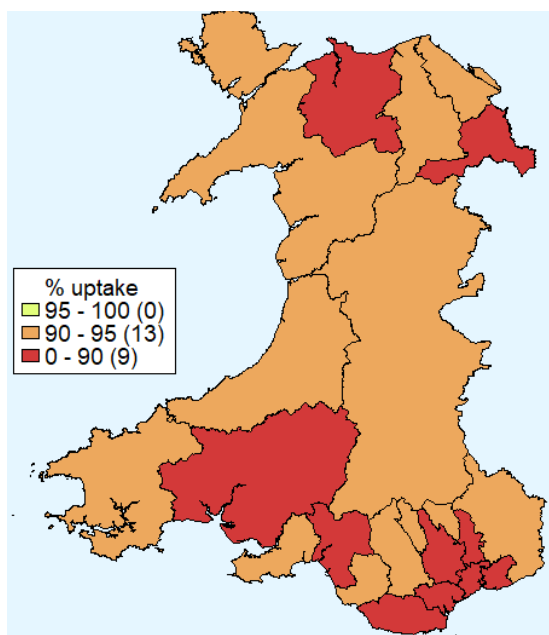


Figure 9. Uptake of “4 in 1” vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/26 and 30/06/26.

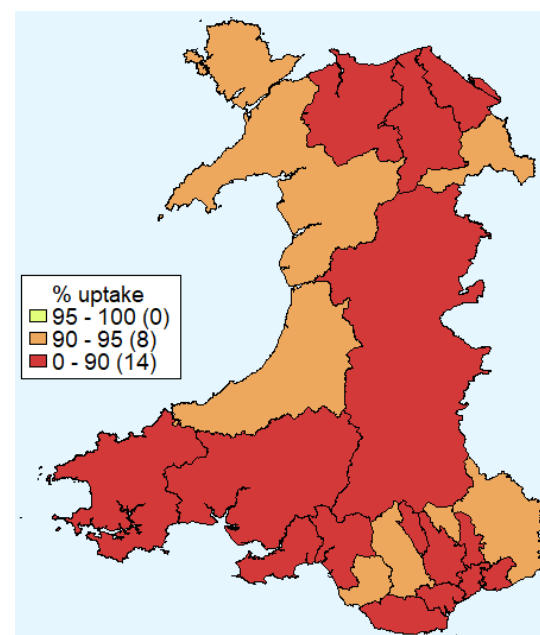
