



Newborn Bloodspot Screening Wales Sample Taker Registration Form

Newborn Bloodspot Screening Wales (NBSW) is establishing a database of all newborn bloodspot screening sample takers in Wales as part of its quality assurance processes.

The database is used as a mechanism to distribute information to sample takers and monitor the quality of the newborn bloodspot screening programme. Individual sample taker performance reports are now produced for registered sample takers.

The database holds information about health professionals as sample takers. Personal details are held securely and confidentially and are not released outside of the programme.

The Nursing and Midwifery Council have given their approval for health professionals to use their NMC PIN as a unique identifier. Please use this as your 'sample taker ID code' which should be recorded in the 'sample taker ID' field on the bloodspot card.

If you do not have an NMC PIN you will be issued with a unique identifier (sample taker ID code) by NBSW after you have completed and returned this registration form. You do not have to wait to receive this ID code before taking further samples.
