\*\*\* A baby with a normal bilateral result,  $\leq$  30dBHL but requires targeted behavioural test (TBT) i.e. cleft palate, Down's Syndrome, should have an assessment result of normal, with a management plan "Refer for Targeted Behavioural Test – Professional decision".
