



Breast Screening - 2020/2021 Inequity Key Messages

This information will help screening and our partners work towards improving uptake and reducing inequities.



Women aged 50 up to 70 were invited to take part in breast screening.

Due to the pandemic, screening paused in March 2020

March 2020

August 2020 to March 2021

Screening started to invite people again, prioritising those who had been waiting the longest.

Fewer people were invited to take part in breast screening.

Uptake = the proportion of eligible invited participants screened within six months of invitation, making this the latest available data as of October 2021.



Youngest (50-54) 62.5%

Oldest (65+) 69%

There was a difference in uptake between women invited for the **first time** and women who had taken up a **previous** screening offer.

First timers 46%

Previous attenders 80%
