Women and people with a cervix aged 25-64 were invited to take part in cervical screening.

Due to the pandemic, screening paused in March 2020.



Screening started to invite people again.

Fewer people were invited to take part in cervical screening.

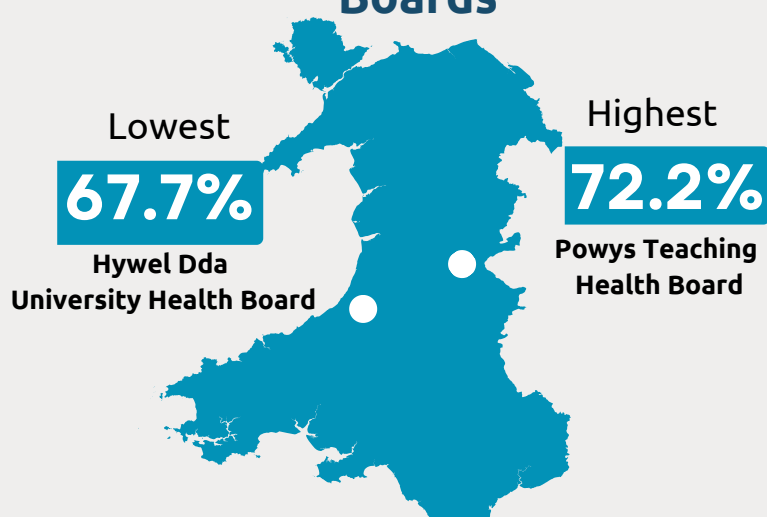
