Vaccine Uptake in Children in Wales COVER Annual Report 2018



Data for the year ending 31 st March 2018

Key points

- In 2017/18 uptake of the '5 in 1' and pneumococcal conjugate vaccinations in one year old children in Wales was over 95% for the tenth consecutive year.
- MenB vaccine uptake in the first full cohort of eligible children reported on was over 95% for two doses. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine was 94%.
- MMR uptake was just below 95% for the first dose at two years.
- MenB uptake was 86% for the complete course at two years. Some children reaching their second birthday during 2017/18 would not have been offered this vaccine, only those born 01/05/2015 onwards were eligible.
- By the fourth birthday, 85% of children were up to date with recommended immunisations; this is stable compared to 2016/17.
- MMR dose two uptake in children at five years of age was just below 90%. Uptake of the pre-school '4 in 1' booster in this age-group was 92%.
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine uptake in girls turning 14 years of age during the 2017/18 school year was 87% for the first dose. Uptake of the complete two-dose course in girls turning 15 years of age was 83%.
- MMR uptake, for a full two-dose course, was 88% and 87% for teenagers turning 15 and 16 years of age respectively during the 2017/18 school year.
- MenACWY vaccine uptake in teenagers turning 15 years of age during the 2017/18 school year was 83%. This is the second School Year 9 cohort to be offered the vaccine.

Background

These annual results for 2017/18 are for one year cohorts of children living in Wales in March 2018 and reaching their first, second, fourth and fifth birthdays between 01/04/2017 and 31/03/2018. Uptake of vaccinations in those reaching 15 and 16 years of age are presented by school year.

Inequalities in uptake of routine vaccinations at four years of age are also presented. National quintiles of deprivation were calculated according to the Lower Super Output Area (LSOA) rankings contained in the Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivation (WIMD 2014). Deprivation rankings contained in the WIMD are relative, not absolute values and they refer to an overall composite measure of factors related to deprivation for all residents in the LSOA as a whole, not the circumstances of individual residents within the LSOA.

Findings

1. '5 in 1'1 vaccine uptake (the third dose) in children reaching their first birthday decreased to 95.9%, from 96.3% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by health board (HB) from 94.2% (Hywel Dda) to 97.4% (Cwm Taf) and by local authority (LA) from 93.9% (Ceredigion and Denbighshire) to 97.7% (Merthyr Tydfil). Sixteen of the 22 LAs achieved the 95% target (Figures 1, 2, 4, 6 and Tables 2, 3).

¹ DTaP/IPV/Hib vaccine protects against diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (Whooping Cough), polio and Hib infection. Scheduled at two, three and four months of age.

- 2. Pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV2²) uptake of a complete two-dose primary course in children at one year of age was 95.9%, ranging by HB from 94.2% (Hywel Dda) to 97.5% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 93.5% (Denbighshire) to 97.7% (Blaenau Gwent) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 3).
- 3. Rotavirus vaccine uptake of two doses in children reaching their first birthday was 93.8% compared to 94.1% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 92.3% (Hywel Dda) to 96.3% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 90.4% (Ceredigion) to 96.7% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 3).
- **4.** Meningococcal serotype B vaccination (MenB³) uptake of two doses in children at one year of age was 95.3%, ranging by HB from 93.5% (Cardiff and Vale) to 97.1% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 93.0% (Cardiff and Ceredigion) to 97.5% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Table 3). This is the first annual report to report on a full cohort of children who would have been eligible for MenB vaccine, which was introduced in September 2015 for those born 1st May 2015 onwards [1].
- 5. MMR⁴ uptake of one dose by two years of age decreased to 94.7%, compared to 95.1% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 93.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.3% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 92.4% (Pembrokeshire) to 96.8% (Caerphilly). Three HBs achieved the target uptake of 95%, and 12 out of 22 LAs exceeded the 95% target (Figures 1, 4, 7 and Tables 2, 4).
- 6. Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf) uptake of the final dose by two years of age was 95.2%. Uptake by HB ranged from 93.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.8% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 92.8% (Cardiff) to 96.9% (Caerphilly, Neath Port Talbot, Rhondda Cynon Taf and Torfaen) (Figure 2 and Tables 2, 4).
- **7.** Hib/MenC⁵ booster uptake by two years of age was 94.5%, ranging by HB from 92.5% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.2% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 91.9% (Cardiff) to 96.7% (Neath Port Talbot) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 4).
- **8.** MenB³ vaccine uptake of a complete course in children at two years of age was 85.5%, ranging by HB from 82.5% (Cardiff and Vale) to 87.1% (Cwm Taf). MenB vaccination was introduced in September 2015 for those born 1st May 2015 onwards, therefore infants turning 2 years of age in April 2017 would not have been eligible [1]. Excluding those who were not eligible, uptake of a complete course was 93.1%.
- **9.** Hib/MenC booster coverage in children by their fourth birthday was 93.3% and ranged by HB from 91.0% (Powys) to 96.2% (Cwm Taf) (Table 5).
- **10.** '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV⁶ 'pre-school booster' uptake in children by four years of age was 88.3%, this ranged by HB from 84.6% (Aneurin Bevan) to 91.8% (Powys) (Table 5).
- **11.** MMR vaccine uptake of a complete two dose course in children by four years of age was 86.2% stable compared to 86.4% last year, this ranged by HB from 83.8% (Aneurin Bevan) to 88.9% (Cwm Taf) (Table 5).
- 12. The percentage of children who were up to date with their Hib/MenC booster, '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV pre-school booster and MMR vaccines by four years of age was 84.9, stable compared to 84.6% last year. This ranged by HB from 81.0% (Aneurin Bevan) to 88.2% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 73.0% (Newport) to 91.0% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figure 3 and Tables 1, 2, 5).

⁵ Hib/MenC vaccine protects against Hib and MenC infections and a routine dose should be offered at 12-13 months of age

² PCV protects against pneumococcal meningitis, bacteraemia, pneumonia and otitis media. Children reaching one year of age would have been offered one dose of PCV at 2 months of age and one dose at 4 months of age. Children reaching two years would have been offered their third and final PCV dose at 12-13 months of age.

³ MenB vaccination was introduced in July 2015 and all infants reaching 2 years of age from 1st May 2017 onwards would have been eligible. Three doses of MenB vaccine should be given at 2, 4 and 12-13 months of age. A small number of infants in the catch-up cohort would have been assigned to a two dose schedule.

- 13. The percentage of children who were up to date with their routine vaccinations by four years of age varied according to the national quintile of deprivation of the LSOA in which they resided. Nationally, the percentage of children up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age ranged from 81.6% in the most deprived quintile of LSOAs to 87.7% in the least deprived quintile of LSOAs. The difference in uptake between the least deprived quintile and the most deprived quintile was 6.2%, stable compared to 6.0% in 2016/17 (Figures 10, 11 and Table 6).
- **14.** MMR uptake of two doses in children at five years of age was 89.5% this year, compared to 90.3% last year, ranging by HB from 86.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 91.4% (Betsi Cadwaladr). Coverage of one dose of MMR in children at five years of age was 96.5% and ranged by HB from 95.0% (Hywel Dda) to 97.4% (Cwm Taf) (Figures 1, 2, 5, 8 and Tables 2, 6).
- **15.** '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV 'pre-school booster' uptake in children reaching their fifth birthday this year was stable at 92.3%, compared to 92.5% in the previous year (Figures 2, 5, 9 and Tables 2, 7).
- **16.** HPV vaccine uptake of one dose in girls in the 2017/18 School Year 9 (reaching their 14th birthday between 01/09/17 and 31/08/18) was 86.6%, stable compared to 86.7% for the 2016/17 School Year 9 group at the time of the previous annual COVER report. Uptake ranged by HB from 79.2% (Aneurin Bevan) to 92.4% (Abertawe Bro Morgannwg) and by LA from 72.0% (Monmouthshire) to 94.7% (Neath Port Talbot). Coverage of two doses of HPV vaccine in girls in the 2017/18 School Year 10 is currently 83.0%, a decrease from 85.8% for the 2016/17 School Year 10 group at the time of the previous annual COVER report (Figure 12 and Table 8) [2].
- 17. MMR coverage of two doses in teenagers turning 15 years of age between 01/09/17 and 31/08/18 was 88.0%, ranging by HB from 78.3% (Powys) to 90.3% (Betsi Cadwaladr) and by LA from 78.3% (Powys) to 92.9% (Gwynedd). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 15 year olds was 92.8%, ranging by LA from 86.3% (Powys) to 95.9% (Gwynedd). A breakdown by sex indicates that 88.5% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella and coverage of one dose was 93.1% (Figure 12 and Table 9).
- **18.** Td/IPV⁷ 'teenage booster' uptake in teenagers reaching 15 years of age between 01/09/17 and 31/08/18 was 83.0%. Uptake ranged by HB from 73.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 89.4% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 71.9% (Cardiff) to 89.9% (Merthyr Tydfil) (Figure 12 and Table 9).
- 19. The MenACWY vaccination programme for teenagers was introduced at the start of the 2015/16 school year, replacing the single antigen meningococcal C teenage booster which was previously given to children in School Year 9 [3]. Coverage in the 2016-17 School Year 10 group, the first Year 9 routine cohort to be offered the new vaccine is currently 81.6%. Coverage in the in the 2017/18 School Year 10 group, the second Year 9 routine cohort to be offered the new vaccine is currently 83.4% (Figure 12 and Table 9).
- 20. MMR coverage of two doses in teenagers turning 16 years of age during the 2017/18 school year was 87.4%, ranging by HB from 82.0% (Powys) to 90.3% (Betsi Cadwaladr) and by LA from 78.2% (Monmouthshire) to 93.8% (Wrexham). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 16 year olds was 92.5%, ranging by LA from 84.5% (Monmouthshire) to 96.1% (Caerphilly). A breakdown by sex indicates that 88.1% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella and coverage of one dose was 93.0% (Table 10).
- **21.** Td/IPV 'teenage booster' uptake in teenagers reaching 16 years during the 2017/18 school year was 84.2%. Uptake ranged by HB from 74.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 91.5% (Cwm Taf) and by LA from 72.2% (Cardiff) to 91.7% (Rhondda Cynon Taff) (Table 10).

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⁷ Td/IPV boosts protection against diphtheria, tetanus and polio infection before entering adulthood.

22. Uptake of hepatitis B immunisation, extracted from the Public Health Wales All Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B immunisation database, is presented in Table 11. The database was developed to assist the Public Health Wales Health Protection Team in the monitoring and follow up of hepatitis B immunisation of babies born to hepatitis B positive mothers and to provide a source for statistics on uptake of hepatitis B immunisation in this group. Uptake of three doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their first birthday in the year ending 31st March 2018 was 79.6%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their second birthday in the year ending 31st March 2018 was 75.5%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their fifth birthday in the year ending 31st March 2018 was 94.6%.

Comment

This is the tenth consecutive year that uptake of both the '5 in 1' vaccine and pneumococcal conjugate vaccines remained above 95% in children at one year of age.

MenB vaccine uptake of two doses in the first full annual cohort of children who were eligible, now at one year of age, is reported. Uptake of a complete course in two-year-old infants born 1st May 2015 to 31st March 2016, the first group of children to be eligible, is also reported. Uptake of two doses at one year of age was over 95% and uptake of a complete course in eligible two year olds was 93%. Whilst the majority of infants turning two years of age between April 2017 and March 2018 would have been on the three-dose schedule, a small number of infants in the catch-up cohort would have been eligible for the two-dose schedule [1]. This suggests continued high levels of acceptability of this recent addition to the childhood vaccination schedule.

The proportion of children who were up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age remained stable this year, following a decrease three years in a row. Of all the immunisations that are included in this composite measure, uptake of the second dose of MMR remains the lowest (86%), followed by the '4 in 1' preschool booster (88%) and Hib/MenC booster (93%).

The inequality gap in immunisation coverage between four year olds residing in the most and least deprived areas remained stable compared to 2016/17, at 6.2%. In every year since this surveillance began in 2012, vaccination uptake in four year olds has been consistently lower in the most deprived areas. Analyses previously carried out by Public Health Wales [4] have shown that inequalities in uptake increase as scheduled vaccination age increases and suggest that repeated offer of catch-up is key in addressing inequalities over the longer-term. Delivery of teenage vaccinations in school settings has also helped in reducing inequities in uptake in teenagers. Further work is needed to identify why inequalities exist and to identify interventions to help reduce this gap.

Uptake of two doses of MMR in five year olds has fallen for the third consecutive year to below 90%. Uptake of two does in children in the 2017/18 school years 10 and 11 also remains below 90%. During April to March 2017/18, there were two outbreaks of measles in South Wales. Spread was limited due to high levels of existing MMR uptake and supplementary immunisation activities to offer catch up immunisation [5, 6], but this highlights the potential for future outbreaks. Given large, ongoing outbreaks across Europe, the risk of imported cases leading to outbreaks in Wales remains high [7]. Vaccination status checking and opportunistic catch-up to ensure that children and teenagers in Wales have received two doses MMR remain key priorities.

Uptake of a complete course of HPV immunisation in year 10 girls (reaching 15 years of age) has decreased for the second year in a row and is now 83%, a fall of 2.8%. However, uptake of MMR1, MMR2 and the '3 in 1' teenage booster in the 2017/18 school year 10 were all higher than in the 2016/17 school year 10 at the same time last year.

Vaccination sessions for the MenACWY vaccine catch-up cohorts are mostly complete. Coverage in the 2017/18 School Years 10, 11 and 12 (turning 15 to 17 years of age) is currently 83.4%, 81.6% and 79.9% respectively [8]. Uptake in those turning 18 years of age during the 2017/18 school year was 78.2% when reported at this time last year, although this may have increased slightly as some individuals may have since been vaccinated in general practice [9]. Uptake in those cohorts eligible to only be vaccinated through General Practice (turning 19, 20 and 21 years of age), remains low (40.4%, 41.6% and 41.8% as at 14/05/2018) but has increased since the same time last year (27%, 37% and 39% as at 15/05/2017) [10].

Overall, in 2017/18, vaccine uptake in young infants remained high and stable. The continuing fall in MMR uptake in children in their early primary school years is of concern and should be actively addressed to maintain elimination of measles in the longer term. Uptake in teenagers continues on a positive trend although the fall in uptake of HPV vaccine over two years is noted. Once again, importance of catch-up is highlighted; and every opportunity should be taken to offer missing MMR and other vaccinations alongside routine teenage immunisations.




Figure 2. Summary of uptake rates for selected immunisations in resident children reaching their 1st, 2nd and 5th birthday between 01/04/2017 and 31/03/2018 and resident on 31/03/2018.




Figure 3. Percentage of resident children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/04/17 and 31/03/18 and are up to date with all scheduled vaccines⁸ by Health Board.




Figure 5. (a) Uptake of two doses of MMR vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/17 and 31/03/18. **(b)** Uptake of '4 in 1' vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 5th birthday between 01/04/17 and 31/03/18.




Figure 6. Annual uptake of '5 in 1' vaccine by 1 year of age (2014 – 2018 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2017/18).




Figure 7. Annual uptake of 1 dose of MMR by 2 years of age (2014 – 2018 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2017/18).




Figure 8. Annual uptake of 2 doses of MMR by 5 years of age (2014 – 2018 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2017/18).




Figure 9. Annual uptake of the '4 in 1' pre-school booster by 5 years of age (2014 – 2018 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2017/18).




Figure 10. Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations⁹ by four years of age, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside. Vaccine uptake is presented for children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/04/2017 and 31/03/2018 and resident on 31/03/2018.






Figure 11. Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations by four years of age during 2012-2018 financial years, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside.
