

# Vaccine Uptake in Children in Wales

## COVER Annual Report 2022

Data for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022



### Key points

- In 2021/22 uptake of the '6 in 1' (DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB) and pneumococcal conjugate vaccinations in one year old children in Wales was 95.2% and 96.6% respectively.
- MenB vaccine uptake was 94.8% for two doses, and uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine was 93.2% at one year.
- MMR uptake was 94.2% for the first dose at two years.
- MenB uptake was 93.8% for the complete course at two years, this is the fourth full cohort of eligible children reported on at two years of age.
- By their fourth birthday, 87.0% of children were up to date with recommended immunisations.
- MMR dose two uptake in children at five years of age was 90.6%, and uptake of the pre-school '4 in 1' (DTaP/IPV) booster in this age-group was 91.2%.
- Human Papillomavirus (HPV) vaccine uptake in children turning 14 years of age during the 2021/22 school year (School Year 9) was 78.9% for the first dose. Uptake of the complete two-dose course in children turning 15 years of age (School Year 10) was 55.1%.
- MMR uptake, for a full two-dose course, was 92.2% and 91.3% for teenagers turning 15 and 16 years of age respectively during the 2021/22 school year.
- MenACWY vaccine uptake in teenagers turning 15 and 16 years of age during the 2021/22 school year was 81.0% and 82.7%.

### Background

These annual results for 2021/22 are for one year cohorts of children living in Wales as at 31/03/2022 and reaching their first, second, fourth and fifth birthdays between 01/04/2021 and 31/03/2022. Uptake of vaccinations in those reaching 15 and 16 years of age are presented by school year.

Inequalities in uptake of routine vaccinations at four years of age are also presented. National quintiles of deprivation were calculated according to the Lower Super Output Area (LSOA) rankings contained in the Welsh Index of Multiple Deprivation (WIMD 2019). Deprivation rankings contained in the WIMD are relative, not absolute values, and they refer to an overall composite measure of factors related to deprivation for all residents in the LSOA as a whole, not the circumstances of individual residents within the LSOA.

Public Health Wales Vaccine Preventable Disease Programme and Communicable Disease Surveillance Centre, working with Powys Teaching Health Board and the NHS Wales Informatics Service, carried out a COVER data quality assurance project at the end of 2018. This project led to improvements in completeness of vaccination data in the national COVER dataset. The impact is that reported vaccination uptake has increased; primarily in children aged four years and older. National trends in this report for 2015 – 2018 are updated to take into account these changes.

## Findings

1. '6 in 1' DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB<sup>1</sup> vaccine uptake (all three doses) in children reaching their first birthday remained stable at 95.2%, compared to 95.6% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by health board (HB) from 92.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 97.2% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by local authority (LA) from 92.4% (Cardiff) to 97.8% (Bridgend). Thirteen of the 22 LAs achieved the 95% target (Figures 1, 2, 5, 7 and Tables 2, 3).
2. Uptake of pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV) in children reaching their first birthday was 96.6%, ranging by HB from 95.0% (Cardiff and Vale) to 98.1% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 94.6% (Cardiff) to 98.4% (Bridgend) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 3). This is the first full annual cohort of children to be on the new one dose primary PCV course [1].
3. Rotavirus vaccine uptake of two doses in children reaching their first birthday remained stable compared to the previous year at 93.2%. Uptake ranged by HB from 90.0% (Cardiff & Vale) to 96.1% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 89.4% (Cardiff) to 96.6% (Bridgend) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 3).
4. Meningococcal serotype B vaccination (MenB) uptake of two doses in children at one year of age was 94.8%, ranging by HB from 91.7% (Cardiff and Vale) to 97.2% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 91.3% (Cardiff) to 97.9% (Bridgend) (Table 3).
5. MMR uptake of one dose by two years of age remained stable at 94.2%, compared to 94.8% in the previous year. Uptake ranged by HB from 91.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.3% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 91.1% (Cardiff) to 96.9% (Bridgend). One HB achieved the target uptake of 95%, and 9 out of 22 LAs exceeded the 95% target (Figures 1, 5, 8 and Tables 2, 4).
6. Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf) uptake of the final dose by two years of age was 94.1%. Uptake by HB ranged from 91.6% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.2% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 90.7% (Cardiff) to 97.0% (Bridgend) (Figure 2 and Tables 2, 4).
7. Hib/MenC booster uptake by two years of age was 93.7%, ranging by HB from 91.1% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.7% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 90.3% (Cardiff) to 96.8% (Anglesey) (Figures 1, 2 and Tables 2, 4).
8. MenB vaccine uptake of a complete course in children at two years of age was 93.8%, ranging by HB from 90.7% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.0% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg), and by LA from 89.8% (Cardiff) to 96.8% (Anglesey).
9. Hib/MenC booster coverage in children by their fourth birthday was 94.8% and ranged by HB from 93.4% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.9% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) (Table 5).
10. '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV 'pre-school booster' uptake in children by four years of age was 88.2%, this ranged by HB from 86.0% (Cardiff and Vale) to 91.0% (Powys) (Table 5).
11. MMR vaccine uptake of a complete two dose course in children by four years of age was 88.0%, this ranged by HB from 85.7% (Cardiff and Vale) to 90.3% (Powys) (Table 5).
12. The percentage of children who were up to date with their Hib/MenC booster, '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV pre-school booster and MMR vaccines by four years of age was 87.0%. This ranged by HB from 84.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 89.2% (Powys) and by LA from 82% (Newport) to 93.1% (Anglesey) (Figure 4 and Tables 1, 2, 5).
13. The percentage of children who were up to date with their routine vaccinations by four years of age varied according to the national quintile of deprivation of the LSOA in which they resided. Nationally, the percentage of children up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age ranged from 82.1% in the most deprived quintile of LSOAs to 90.6% in the least deprived quintile of LSOAs. The difference in uptake between

the least deprived quintile and the most deprived quintile was 8.5 percentage points (Figures 11, 12 and Table 6).

14. MMR uptake of two doses in children at five years of age was 90.6%, ranging by HB from 88.3% (Cardiff and Vale) to 93.0% (Betsi Cadwaladr). Coverage of one dose of MMR in children at five years of age was 95.9% and ranged by HB from 93.5% (Powys) to 97.1% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) (Figures 1, 2, 6, 9 and Tables 2, 7).
15. '4 in 1' DTaP/IPV 'pre-school booster' uptake in children reaching their fifth birthday this year was 91.2% (Figures 2, 6, 10 and Tables 2, 7).
16. HPV vaccine uptake in the full 2021/22 School Year 9 group (reaching their 14<sup>th</sup> birthday between 01/09/21 and 31/08/22) was 78.9%. This is an increase compared to the previous years' cohort, where uptake was 67.4%. Uptake ranged by HB from 73.8% (Betsi Cadwaladr) to 91.1% (Swansea Bay) and by LA from 61.0% (Denbighshire) to 91.5% (Neath Port Talbot). Coverage of two doses of HPV vaccine in girls in the 2021/22 School Year 10 is currently 55.1%, this is a slight decrease compared to the previous school year cohort at the same point last year, where uptake was 56.5% (Figure 13 and Table 8).
17. MMR coverage of two doses in teenagers turning 15 years of age between 01/09/21 and 31/08/22 was 92.2%, ranging by HB from 89.7% (Hywel Dda) to 93.7% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 87.9% (Pembrokeshire) to 95.2% (Torfaen). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 15 year olds was 95.6%, ranging by LA from 93.0% (Pembrokeshire) to 98.2% (Torfaen). A breakdown by sex indicates that 92.5% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella and coverage of one dose was 95.8% (Figure 13 and Table 9).
18. Td/IPV 'teenage booster' uptake in teenagers reaching 15 years of age between 01/09/21 and 31/08/22 was 80.9%. Uptake ranged by HB from 74.5% (Aneurin Bevan) to 89.0% (Swansea Bay) and by LA from 68.1% (Blaenau Gwent) to 89.7% (Swansea) (Figure 13 and Table 9).
19. Coverage of MenACWY vaccine in the 2021/22 School Year 10 group is currently 81.0%. Coverage in the 2021/22 School Year 11 group is currently 82.7% (Figure 13, Table 9 and 10).
20. MMR coverage of two doses in teenagers turning 16 years of age during the 2021/22 school year was 91.3%, ranging by HB from 87.1% (Powys) to 92.9% (Betsi Cadwaladr) and by LA from 87.1% (Powys) to 94.8% (Caerphilly). Coverage of one dose of MMR in 16 year olds was 94.9%, ranging by LA from 91.6% (Powys) to 97.7% (Caerphilly). A breakdown by sex indicates that 91.8% of girls had received a full (two MMR doses) course of immunisation against rubella and coverage of one dose was 95.3% (Table 10).
21. Td/IPV 'teenage booster' uptake in teenagers reaching 16 years during the 2021/22 school year was 82.5%. Uptake ranged by HB from 77.3% (Hywel Dda) to 90.8% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 61.3% (Pembrokeshire) to 91.1% (Rhondda Cynon Taf) (Table 10).
22. Uptake of hepatitis B immunisation in babies at risk of perinatal infection, extracted from the Public Health Wales All Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B immunisation database, is presented in Table 11. The database was developed to assist the Public Health Wales Health Protection Team in the monitoring and follow up of hepatitis B immunisation of babies born to hepatitis B positive mothers and to provide a source for statistics on uptake of hepatitis B immunisation in this group. Uptake of three doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their first birthday in the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 was 96.9%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their second birthday in the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 was 74.4%. Uptake of four doses in children who were at risk of perinatal infection and reached their fifth birthday in the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> March 2022 was 65.9%.

## Comment

The majority of children in this report for the April 2021 to March 2022 year would have been due their immunisations during the COVID-19 pandemic. Although coverage for younger children who receive their immunisations in general practice remains positive, there has been a slight decreasing trend over the previous four quarters [2].

For the annual cohort of one year olds, uptake of the '6 in 1' and pneumococcal conjugate vaccines remained above 95%, although uptake continues to vary between health board areas.

Uptake of two doses of Men B vaccine at one year of age was slightly below 95% at 94.8%; with uptake of a complete three-dose course in two year olds slightly lower (93.8%). Uptake of MMR1 at two years of age remains slightly below 95% for the full year cohort with uptake in the most recent quarterly cohort (Jan to Mar 2022) 93.9% and uptake in the first quarterly cohort (Apr to Jun 2021) 94.8% [2].

The proportion of children who were up to date with their routine immunisations by four years of age decreased slightly this year to 87.0%, from 87.6%. Of all the immunisations that are included in this composite measure, uptake of the second dose of MMR remains the lowest (88.0%), followed by the '4 in 1' preschool booster (88.2%) then Hib/MenC booster (94.8%).

The reported inequality gap in immunisation coverage between four year olds residing in the most and least deprived areas remained stable compared to 2020/21, at 8.5 percentage points. Coverage has decreased across most quintiles, with the exception of the second least deprived quintile where coverage increased slightly. Further work is needed to identify the root cause of these inequalities and identify interventions to reduce this gap in addition to existing enhanced primary care nursing services including Flying Start.

Coverage of immunisations in teenagers is lower compared to previous years. School based vaccination sessions were disrupted during the 2020/21 academic year due to school closures and catch-up activities were planned. There were no school closures during the 2021/22 school year, but for part of the academic year there was still a requirement to self-isolate following a positive COVID-19 test, which could have disrupted immunisation sessions for some schools. The 2021/22 School Year 9 cohort was the second to include boys as part of the HPV vaccination programme, uptake of one dose in these children is currently 78.9% (82.1% for girls and 75.9% for boys) [3]. Of all the vaccinations given to teenagers, HPV uptake continues to be the most impacted by school closures during the COVID-19 pandemic period.

Social distancing measures implemented in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, reducing transmission of infections and reduced reporting during this time has led to fewer notifications of vaccine preventable disease. However, there remains potential for outbreaks in Wales following importation from people acquiring measles virus abroad now travel has resumed and there is a need to monitor vaccination uptake more closely and ensure catch up in areas that may be at risk of outbreaks.

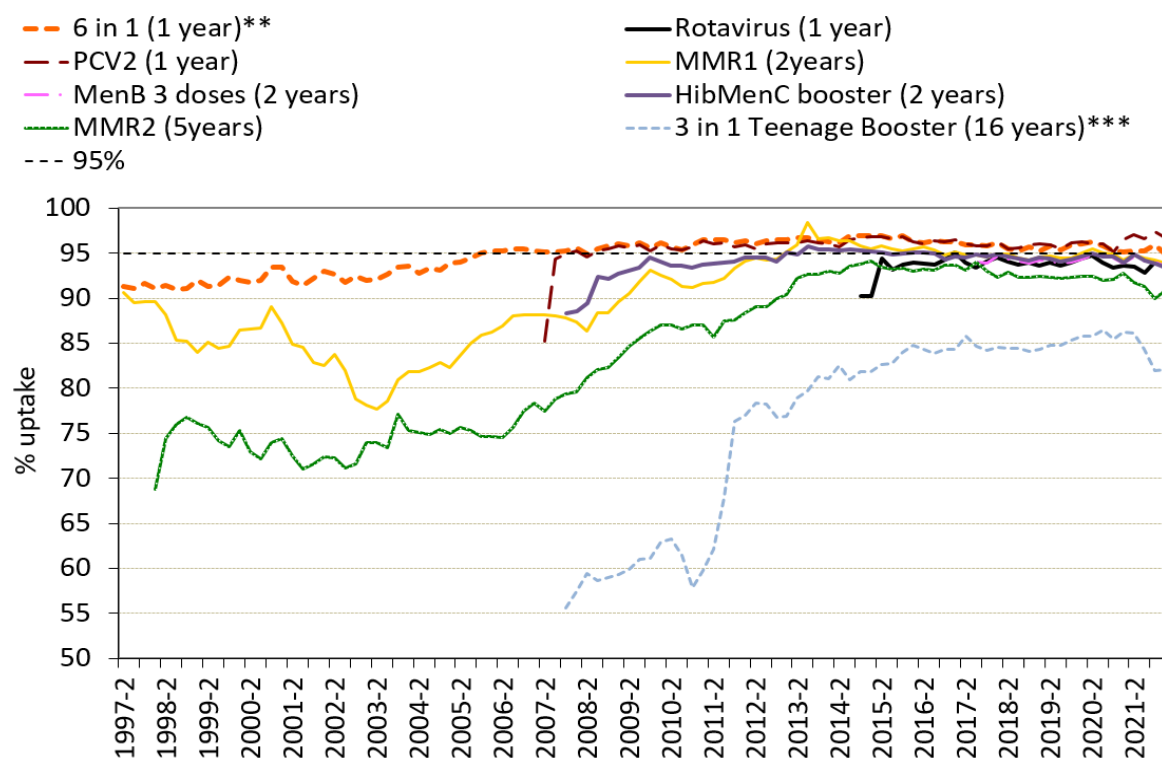

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**Figure 1.** Percentage uptake of childhood immunisations in Wales, quarter 2 1997 to quarter 1 2022\*.

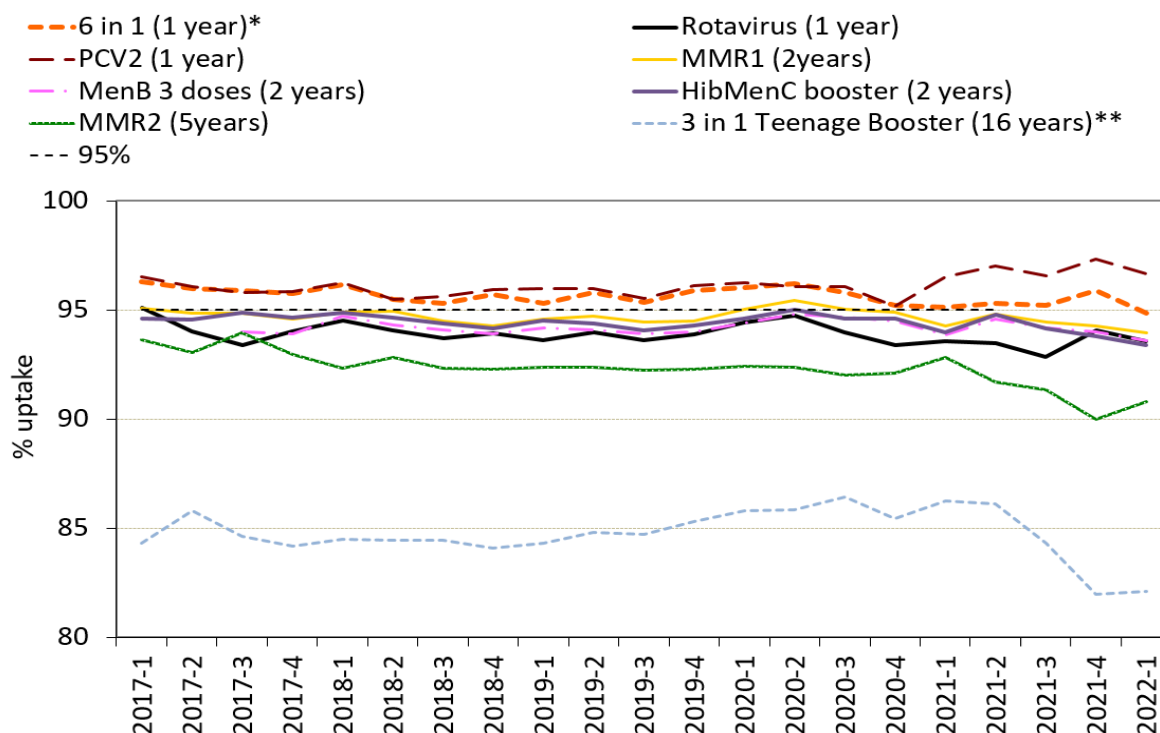

**Figure 2.** Percentage uptake of childhood immunisations in Wales, quarter 1 2017 to quarter 1 2022\*\*

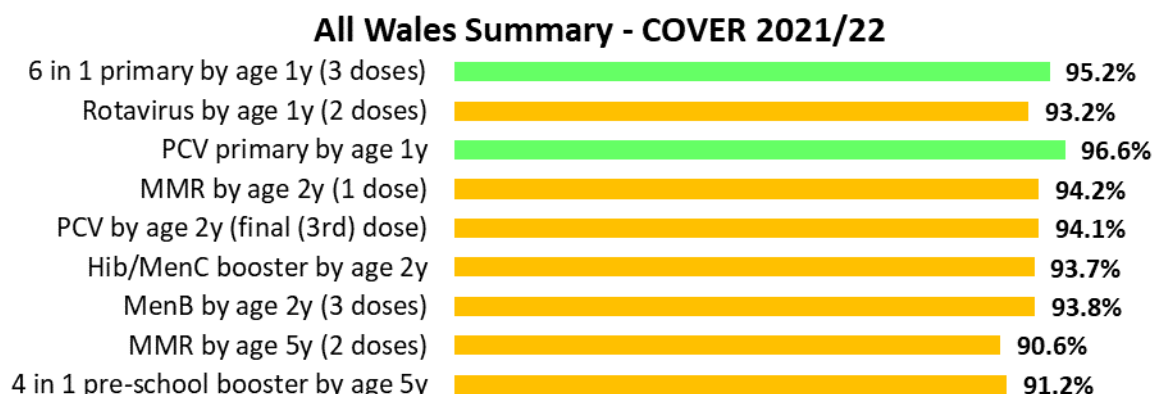

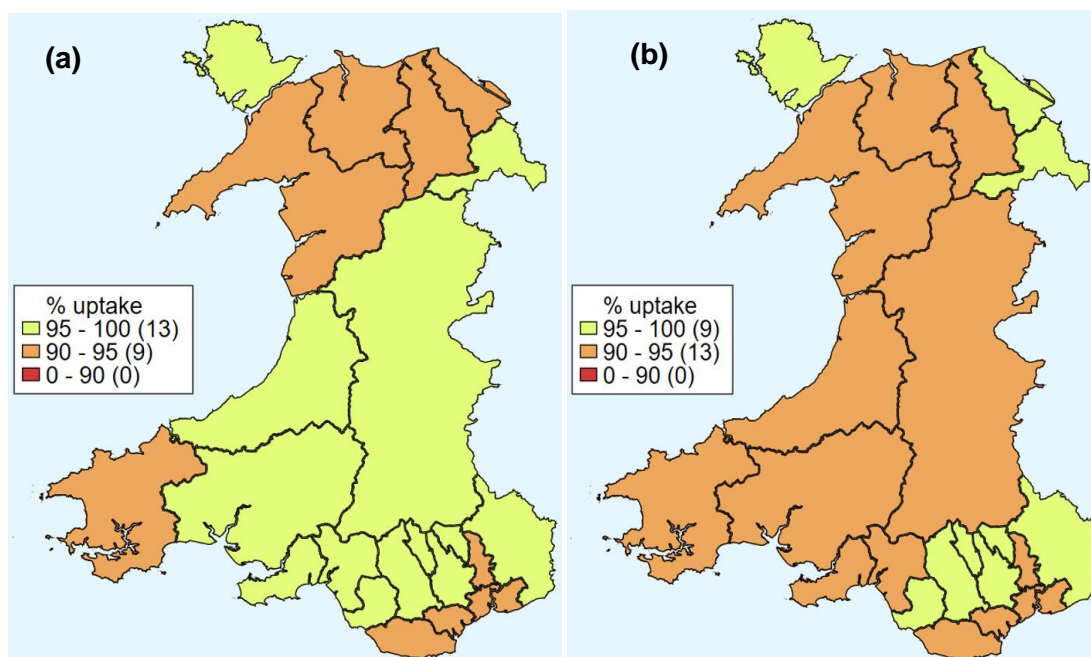

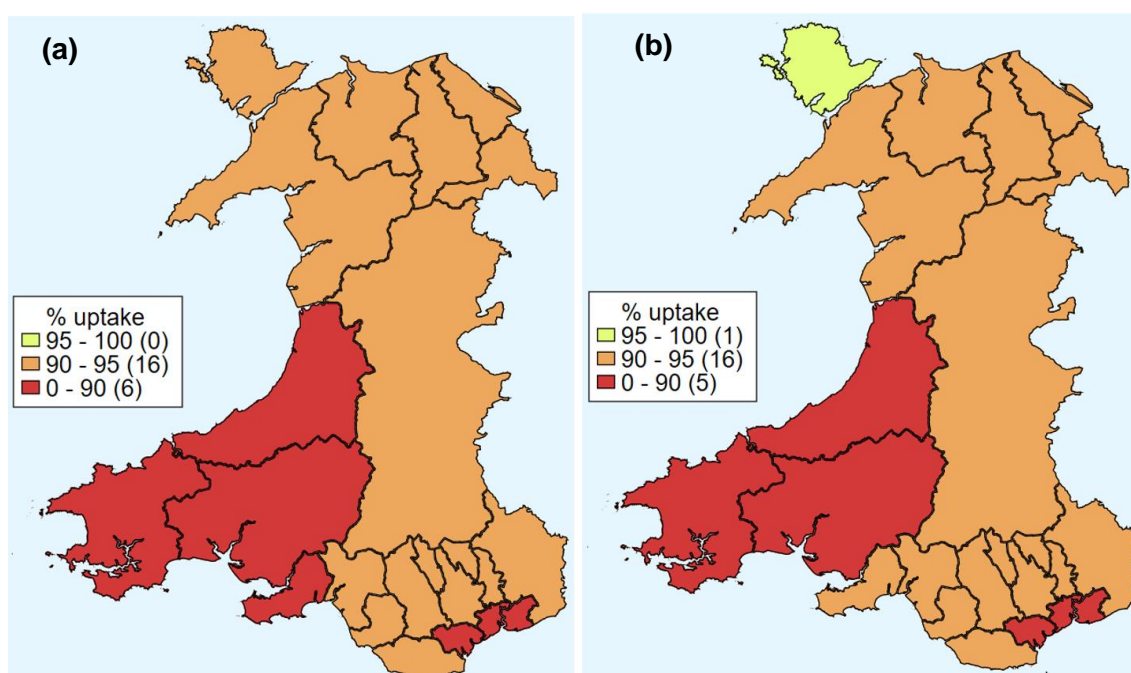

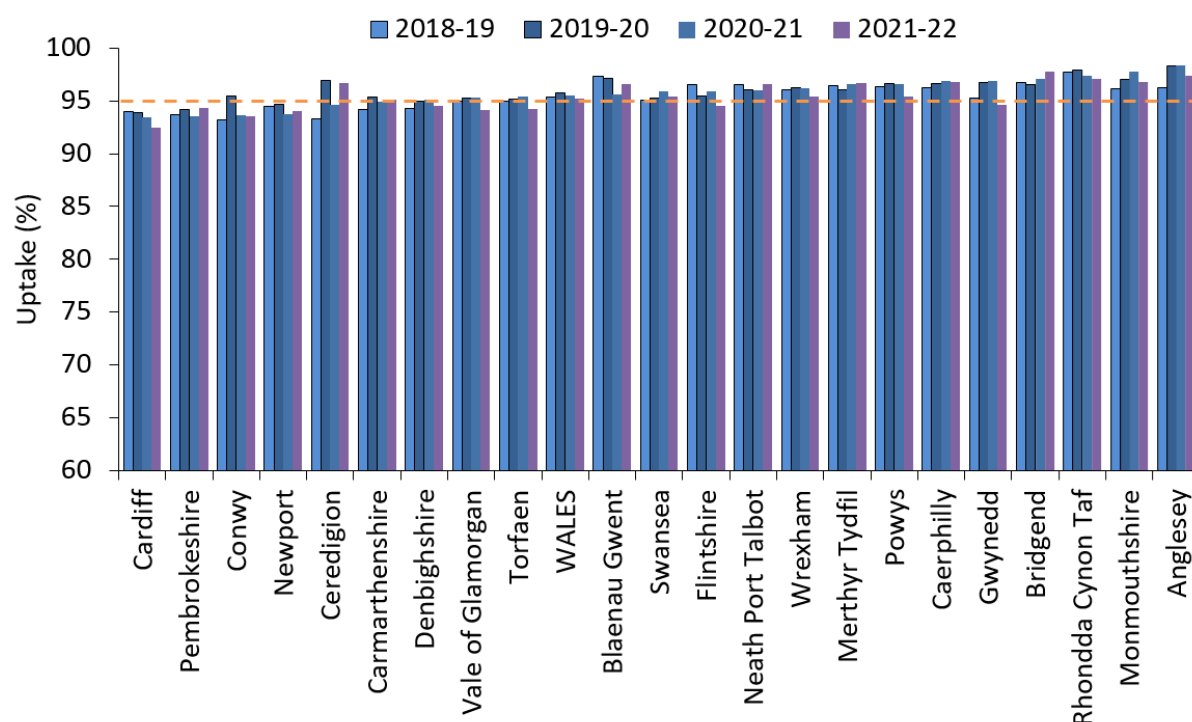
**Figure 5. (a)** Uptake of '6 in 1' vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 1<sup>st</sup> birthday between 01/04/21 and 31/03/22. **(b)** Uptake of at least 1 dose of MMR immunisation in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday between 01/04/21 and 31/03/22.

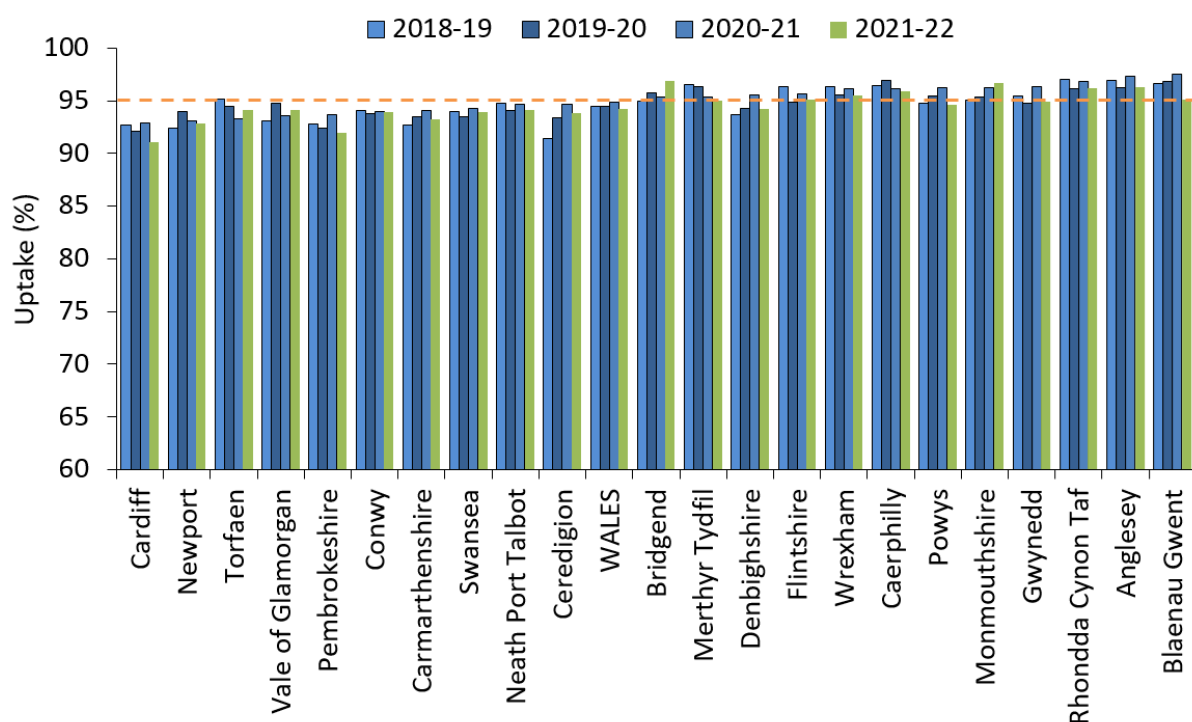


**Figure 7.** Annual uptake of '5 in 1' or '6 in 1' vaccine by 1 year of age (2018 – 2022 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2021/22).<sup>1</sup>

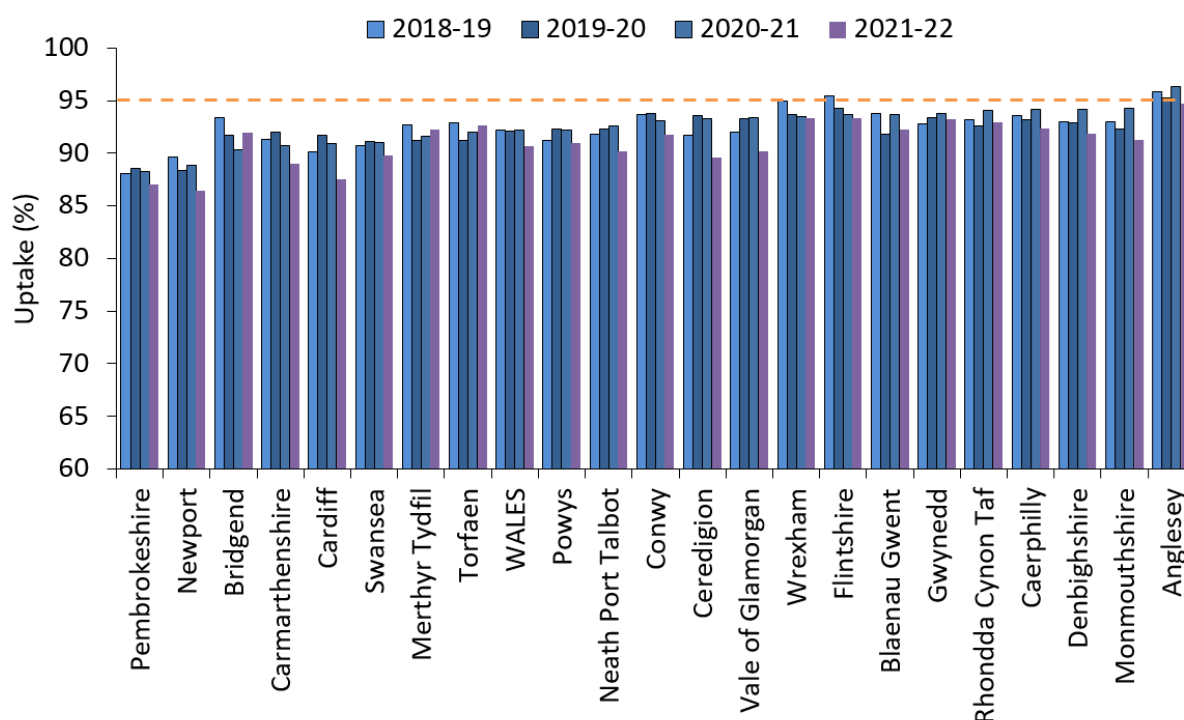

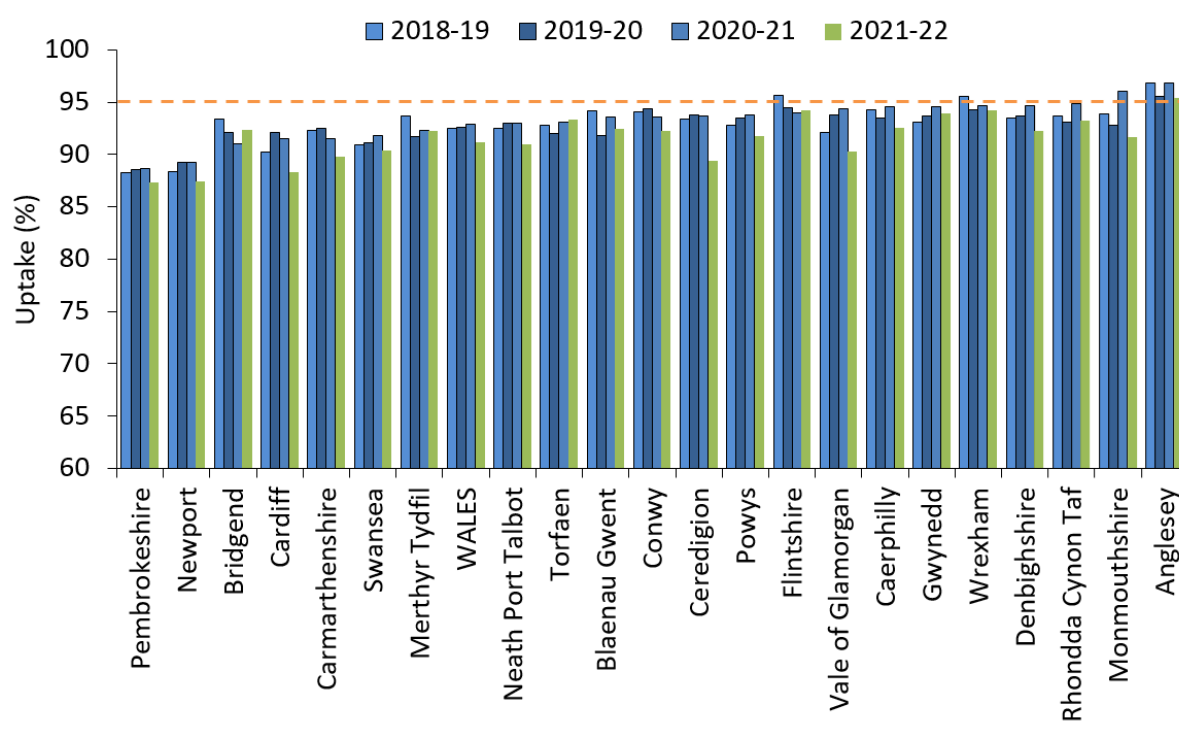
**Figure 8.** Annual uptake of 1 dose of MMR by 2 years of age (2018 – 2022 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2021/22).



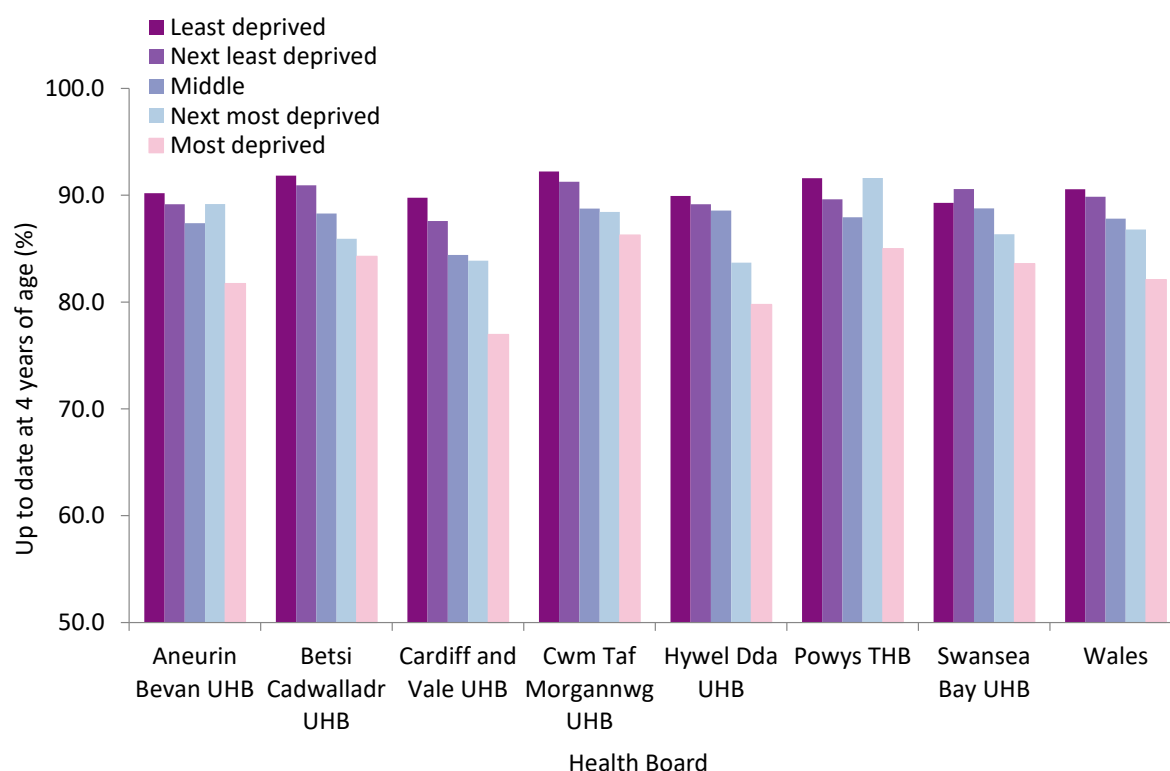
**Figure 9.** Annual uptake of 2 doses of MMR by 5 years of age (2018 – 2022 financial years, ranked by uptake in 2021/22).

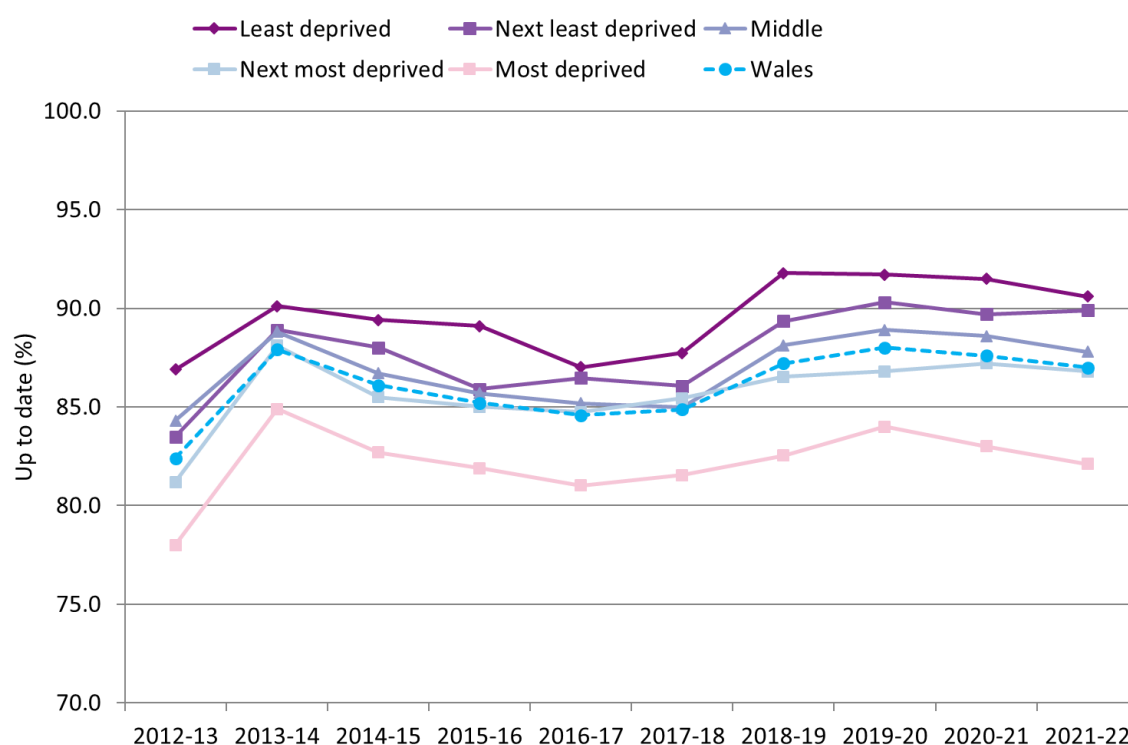


**Figure 11.** Percentage of children who are up to date with routine immunisations<sup>1</sup> by four years of age, by quintile of deprivation of the Lower Super Output Area in which they reside. Vaccine uptake is presented for children reaching their 4th birthday between 01/04/2021 and 31/03/2022 and resident on 31/03/2022.



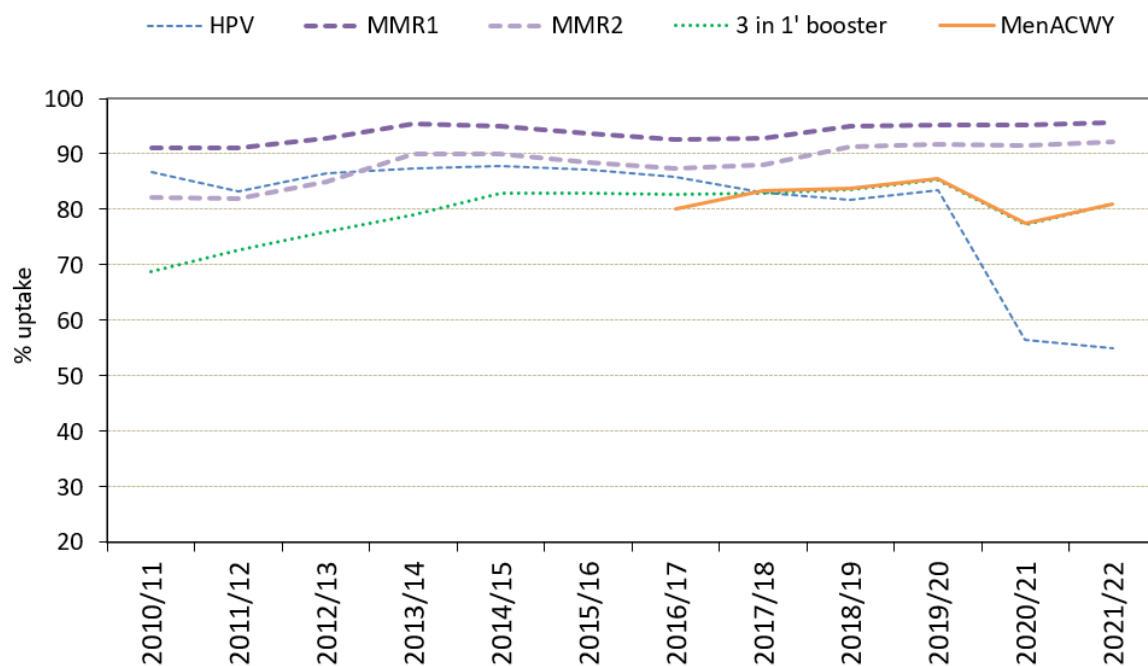
