

# Vaccine Uptake in Children in Wales

## July to September 2022

#### Key points

- For children at one year of age, uptake of the “6 in 1” and two doses of MenB was below 95%. Uptake of pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV) was 96.3%. Uptake of two doses of Rotavirus vaccine was 91.8%.
- Uptake of a complete three-dose course of MenB vaccine in two year olds was 92.5% this quarter. One HB and six LA areas had an uptake above 95%.
- Uptake of the first dose of MMR vaccine in two year old children was 93.1% this quarter. One HBs and seven LA areas achieved an uptake of 95% or over.
- The proportion of children up to date with all routine immunisations by four years of age was 84.5% this quarter and was 88.9% in five year olds.
- Routine school based vaccination sessions for teenagers are now complete for the 2021-22 academic year. Uptake of one dose of HPV vaccine in 2021-22 school year 8 children was 66.3%.
- Coverage of the first dose of HPV vaccine in 2021-22 school year 9 (13-14 year olds) is currently 81.9%. Coverage of the second dose of HPV vaccine in 2021-22 school year 10 (14-15 year olds) is currently 72.7%.
- Uptake of routine MenACWY vaccine in the 2021-22 school year 9 cohort was 71.0%. Coverage of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2021-22 school year 10 cohort is 82.2%.
- Uptake of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2021-22 school year 9 cohort was 70.9%. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2021-22 school year 10 is 82.1%.
- Coverage of one dose of MMR vaccine in the 2021-22 school year 10 (age 14-15 years) was 95.3%, coverage of two doses was 92.0%.
- Coverage of one dose of MMR vaccine in the 2021-22 school year 11 (age 15-16 years) was 94.7%, coverage of two doses is 91.1%.

#### Background

These results are for children living in Wales in September 2022 and reaching their first, second, fourth, fifth and 16<sup>th</sup> birthdays during the quarter 01/07/2022 to 30/09/2022. Uptake of key immunisations in older children, which are mainly provided through school based programmes in all areas other than Cardiff and Vale University Health Board, are presented in school year cohorts (children reaching their 14<sup>th</sup>, 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> birthdays between 01/09/2021 and 31/08/2022). BCG immunisation uptake data are also presented here for children vaccinated selectively following risk assessment. Coverage of neonatal hepatitis B immunisation in infants at risk is also presented, using data from the Public Health Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B database.

## Findings

1. Uptake of all three doses of the combined “6 in 1” DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB<sup>1</sup> vaccine, scheduled at two, three and four months of age, in children reaching their first birthday was 94.7% this quarter, compared to 94.0% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 94.0% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.8% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 91.3% (Torfaen and Denbighshire) to 98.7% (Anglesey). One of the seven HBs and eight of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2, 3 and 6, Tables 2 and 3).
2. Uptake of pneumococcal conjugate vaccination (PCV) in children reaching their first birthday increased to 96.3% this quarter, compared to 95.9% last quarter. This is the seventh quarterly cohort of children to be on the new one dose primary PCV course [1]. Uptake ranged by LA from 93.5% (Gwynedd) to 100.0% (Anglesey). Six of the seven HBs and 16 of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 3).
3. Uptake of two doses of MenB vaccine, scheduled at two and four months of age, in children reaching their first birthday was 94.6% this quarter. Uptake in HBs ranged from 93.4% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.9% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 91.3% (Denbighshire) to 98.7% (Anglesey) (Figure 3, Tables 2 and 3).
4. Uptake of two doses of rotavirus vaccine in children reaching their first birthday was 91.8% this quarter, compared to 92.1% last quarter. Uptake in HBs ranged from 89.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.6% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 84.3% (Denbighshire) to 96.8% (Anglesey) (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 3).
5. Uptake of the first dose of MMR<sup>2</sup> in children reaching their second birthday (scheduled at 12 to 13 months of age) was 93.1% this quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 89.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.9% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA area from 88.6% (Cardiff) to 97.2% (Caerphilly). One HB and seven LA areas achieved the target of 95% uptake (Figures 2, 3 and 7, Tables 2 and 4).
6. Uptake of the complete three dose course of MenB vaccine in children reaching their second birthday decreased again this quarter to 92.5% compared to 93.0% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 87.6% (Cardiff and Vale) to 95.7% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 87.3% (Cardiff) to 97.1% (Bridgend). One of the seven HBs and six of the 22 LA areas achieved the target 95% uptake (Figures 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 4).
7. Uptake of the final dose of Pneumococcal Conjugate Vaccine (PCVf, scheduled at 12 to 13 months of age) in children reaching their second birthday was 92.8%. Uptake ranged by HB from 88.0% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.2% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 88.4% (Vale of Glamorgan) to 97.3% (Bridgend). One HB and six LA areas achieved an uptake of 95% or over (Figure 3, Tables 2 and 4).
8. Uptake of the Hib/MenC booster (given at 12 to 13 months of age) in children reaching two years of age decreased to 92.7% this quarter compared to 93.1% last quarter. Uptake ranged by HB from 88.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 96.1% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and ranged by LA from 88.3% (Cardiff) to 97.1% (Bridgend). One HB and six LA areas achieved uptakes in excess of 95% (Figures 1, 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 4).
9. In children reaching four years of age this quarter (Table 5), uptake of:
  - The “4 in 1” DTaP/IPV<sup>3</sup> pre-school booster was 85.4%
  - The Hib/MenC booster was 94.4%
  - Two doses of MMR was 85.3%

The proportion of children who were up to date with all these routine immunisations at four years of age was 84.5%. This ranged by HB from 80.2% (Cardiff and Vale) to 89.3% (Powys) and by LA from 78.6% (Torfaen) to 91.6% (Anglesey) (Figures 4 and 5, Tables 1, 2 and 5).

10. The proportion of children who were up to date with routine immunisations by their fifth birthday was 88.9%, a decrease compared to 89.7% last quarter. This ranged by HB from 85.8% (Cardiff and Vale) to 90.7% (Betsi Cadwaladr) (Table 6).
11. In children reaching five years of age this quarter, coverage of one dose of MMR was 95.8%. Coverage of two doses of MMR was 90.0%. Coverage of two doses of MMR ranged by HB from 87.6% (Cardiff and Vale) to 91.7% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 86.6% (Carmarthenshire) to 95.5% (Anglesey) (Figures 1, 2, 3 and 8, Tables 2, 6 and 7).
12. Uptake of the “4 in 1” DTaP/IPV<sup>3</sup> pre-school booster in children reaching their fifth birthday decreased to 90.5% this quarter compared to 91.1% last quarter, ranging by HB from 87.9% (Cardiff and Vale) to 92.1% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg) and by LA from 86.9% (Cardiff) to 96.1% (Anglesey). One of the 22 LAs achieved the 95% uptake target (Figure 3 and 9, Tables 2, 6 and 7).
13. Uptake of the first dose of HPV vaccine for children in the 2021-22 school year 8 cohort (turning 13 years of age during 01/09/21 to 31/08/22) was 66.3%. This is the third school cohort to include boys eligible for the HPV vaccine (Table 8a) [2].
14. Coverage of the first dose of HPV vaccine in the 2021-22 school year 9 cohort is currently 81.9% (84.7% in girls and 79.1% in boys) and uptake of the second dose in this age group was 67.6% (70.6% in girls and 64.8% in boys) (Table 8b).
15. Coverage of a complete two dose course of HPV vaccine in the 2021-22 school year 10 cohort (reaching their 15<sup>th</sup> birthday during 01/09/21 to 31/08/22) is currently 72.7% (Table 9). This is the first school cohort to include boys eligible for the HPV vaccine. Uptake in this cohort would have been affected by paused vaccination sessions in schools following COVID-19 measures.
16. Uptake of the MenACWY vaccine in the 2021-22 routine school year 9 cohort was 71.0% (Table 10 and 11). Coverage in the 2021-22 school years 10, 11 and 12, is currently 82.2%, 83.6% and 86.3% respectively (Table 10).
17. Uptake of the Td/IPV<sup>4</sup> teenage booster in the 2021-22 school year 9 (children reaching 14 years of age) was 70.9%. Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group is currently 92.3% and coverage of one dose is 95.3%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 89.6% (Powys) to 94.4% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 14 year old girls in this school year group was 92.8% (Table 11).
18. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2021-22 school year 10 (children reaching 15 years of age) is currently 82.1%. Coverage ranged by HB from 75.5% (Cardiff and Vale) to 89.9% (Swansea Bay). Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 92.0% and coverage of one dose was 95.3%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 89.2% (Hywel Dda) to 93.6% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 15 year old girls in this school year group was 92.3% (Table 12).
19. Coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in the 2021-22 school year 11 (children reaching 16 years of age) is currently 83.4%. Coverage ranged by HB from 79.1% (Cardiff and Vale) to 90.8% (Cwm Taf Morgannwg). Coverage of two doses of MMR in this year group was 91.1% and coverage of one dose was 94.7%. Coverage of two doses of MMR vaccine ranged by HB from 87.3% (Powys Teaching) to 92.7% (Betsi Cadwaladr). Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 16 year old girls in this school year group was 91.6% (Table 13).
20. Coverage of two doses of MMR in children reaching 16 years of age this quarter (between 1<sup>st</sup> July 2022 and 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022) was 91.6%, whilst coverage of one dose of MMR was 95.0%. Coverage of a full course of immunisation against rubella (two doses of MMR) in 16 year old girls was 92.3%. National coverage of the Td/IPV teenage booster in children reaching 16 years of age this quarter was 83.5% (Figures 1, 2 and 3, Tables 2 and 14).

- 21.** Uptake of BCG immunisation is presented in Table 15. These data are based on BCG immunisations recorded in the National Community Child Health Database. BCG immunisation has been received by 6.9%, 7.8%, 7.6% and 6.1% of children reaching their first, second, fifth and 16<sup>th</sup> birthdays (respectively) during quarter three of 2022. This quarter Cardiff LA had the highest proportion of children given BCG by one year of age (17.6%), two years of age (20.6%), five years of age (17.3%) and sixteen years of age (15.1%).
- 22.** Uptake data for hepatitis B immunisation in children who were at risk of perinatal infection, extracted from the Public Health Wales All Wales Neonatal Hepatitis B Immunisation Database, is presented in Table 16. This quarter uptake of three doses of hepatitis B vaccine at their first birthday was 100.0%, uptake of four doses at their second birthday was 77.8% and uptake of four doses at their fifth birthday was 78.6%. Proportions should be interpreted with caution as small numbers of babies require an enhanced course of hepatitis B immunisation.

## **Comment**

This is the eighth quarterly COVER report containing vaccination uptake for infants and younger children who would have been due their vaccinations since social restrictions around the COVID-19 pandemic were first in place in March 2020 and may have experienced varying levels of disruption accordingly.

For the July to September 2022 quarter, uptake of the complete three-dose course of “6 in 1” and two doses of MenB vaccine by the first birthday increased but remain slightly below 95%. Uptake of PCV in infants remained above 95%.

Uptake of the first MMR dose by two years continued to decrease, for the fifth consecutive quarter, to 93.1%. This is the same trend seen for all vaccinations reported on at two years of age.

The proportion of children who were up to date with their routine immunisations by four years decreased slightly again this quarter. Coverage continues to vary by health board. Uptake of two doses of MMR vaccine remains the lowest of all vaccinations included in this composite measure.

School immunisation sessions for older children were suspended after the closure of schools on 20 March 2020, affecting routine Td/IPV, MenACWY and HPV vaccination, and opportunistic MMR catch-up. A phased return to schools began on 29 June 2020, with full reopening on 1 September 2020. All secondary schools and colleges moved to online learning from the 14<sup>th</sup> December 2020. Wales entered alert level 4 and a second full lockdown on the 20<sup>th</sup> December 2020 [3]. A phased return to school began on 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2021 with younger children returning first and a full reopening of all schools from 12<sup>th</sup> April 2021.

Teenage 3 in 1 booster and MenACWY vaccination sessions for School Year 9 are now complete for 2021-22. Uptake was 70.9% and 71.0%, respectively. This remains lower than uptake of these vaccinations before the pandemic, which was 84.0% for both vaccines in the 2018-19 school year 9 cohort at the end of August 2019 [4]. Catch-up should be encouraged throughout the 2022-23 school year.

Of all the teenage vaccines, uptake of the HPV vaccine appears to be the most impacted by school interruptions during the pandemic. Uptake of the second dose in 2021-22 school year 9 children was 67.6%, whilst coverage in the 2020-21 school year 9 increased from 39.8% to 72.7% after a catch-up sessions throughout the 2021-22 school year. MMR coverage in teenagers remains stable.

On World Polio Day, 24<sup>th</sup> October 2022, Welsh Government released a Welsh Health Circular (WHC) outlining the need for an urgent polio catch-up programme for children under 5 years old [5]. This is in response to an incident in North London where type 2 vaccine-derived Polio virus has been found in sewage samples [6]. Coverage of three doses of polio containing vaccine at one year of age was over the WHO target of 95% from 2007 to 2021, but has decreased in recent quarters. Coverage of the polio containing “4in1” preschool booster dose measured at 4 years remains lower and has decreased from 89.2% in quarter 4 of 2021 to 85.4% this quarter. This urgent catch-up programme, with completion encouraged by the end of January 2023. The WHC also highlights the importance of ensuring vaccination records in both the GP and Child Health system are accurate and up to date.

There remains the potential for resurgent infections following relaxation of restriction on movement. **Catch-up of routine vaccinations at every opportunity, especially around school entry and alongside school vaccination sessions, remains a priority in averting large outbreaks of vaccine-preventable infections.**



The data was sourced from Community Child Health databases maintained by local Child Health Office staff in Trusts throughout Wales based on regular returns from nurses and doctors who immunise or advise on immunisation. Uptake data presented throughout are for HB resident population, not for HB GP practice populations. The maps, graphs, tables 1 and 2 are best viewed in colour.

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**Figure 1.** Percentage uptake of childhood immunisations in Wales, quarter 2 1997 to quarter 3 2022\*.








**Figure 5.** Trends in the percentages of children reaching their 4<sup>th</sup> birthday during quarter 1 2015 to quarter 3 2022, who are up to date with all scheduled vaccines<sup>7</sup>, by health board.




**Figure 6.** Uptake of “6 in 1” vaccine in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 1<sup>st</sup> birthday between 01/07/22 and 30/09/22.




**Figure 7.** Uptake of at least one dose of MMR immunisation in Welsh Local Authority areas in children reaching their 2<sup>nd</sup> birthday between 01/04/22 and 30/09/22.
