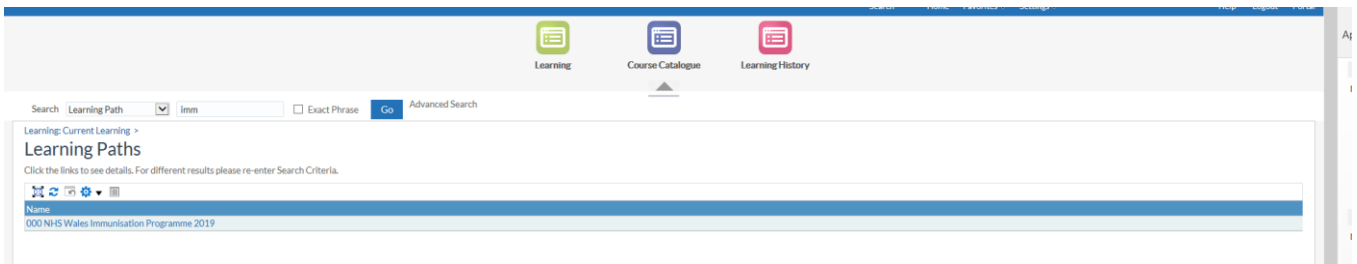
2. Change the dropdown here to Learning Path

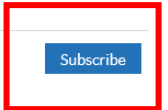

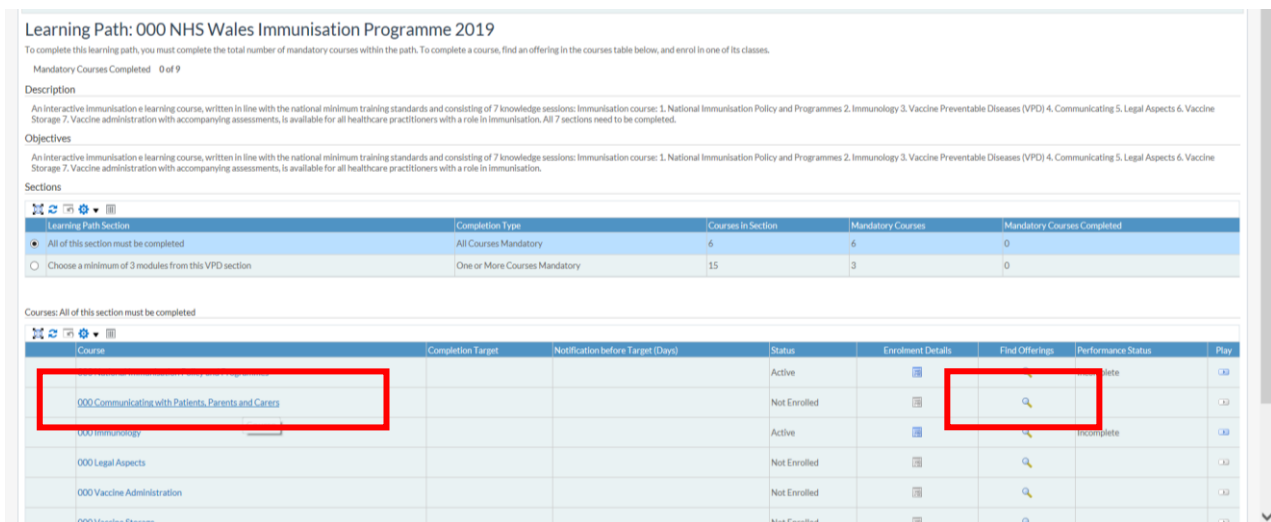
